

New York, N.Y. - Discussion of Indian independence has been marked by a general ignoring of the plight of the 70,000,000 Untouchables who are to the other Indians what the U.S. Negroes are to American whites. In The Crisis for December, Harry Paxton Howard, Far East expert, tells all about these oppressed people in an article entitled "the 'Negroes' of India".
