Mrs. Kathleen Jenkins-Livingstone passed her examinations as an elocutionist making a mark of 92.

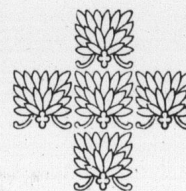
Many of our boys in training here have been moved to various stations.

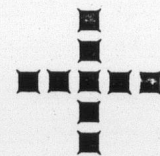
