# **Davis Trial Seen** As Test Of System

PALO ALTO, Calif. (AP)—Black revolutionary Angela Davis says if she is aequitted of murder-kidnap charges it will be a victory for the people, not the judicial system. However, she said: "If I am convicted, I will see the jurors as having been willing or unwilling accomplices in a conspiracy presented by the state."

As she prepares for trial Jan. 31, she worries that some people are supporting her only because they believe she had nothing to do with the state."


