NEW YORK, May 7-In the death of former Senator Robert F. Wagner of New York 'he nation lost "one of the truly great Americans of the WEEKLY Twentieth Century." Walter White DARKER RACES executive secretary of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, said in a telegram of condolence to the son of the lat champion of civil rights.

Mr. Wagner died on May 4 after a long illness. After representing New York in the United States Senate for almost 23 years he retired in 1949 because of illness. In the Senate he sponsored and worked for enactent of anti-lynching, anti-poll tax and other civil rights legislation as well as for labor and welfare meas-

"To him more than to any other person of our time is due credit for the fact that there were no lynchings last year," Mr. White said, "Although he was never able to get past senate filibuster in enactment o the anti-lynching bills he championed, the focusing of public attention on the evil by his fight for such legislation awoke America to the dangers of mob violence . . . We of the NAACP mourn his loss."
