Instead of becoming discouraged, FDR House accepted the situation as a challenge and strove to prove that democracy could be more than a word. Members started a houseto-house canvass among neighbors in a two-block area to find out what New their objections to the co-op were. Questions posed to the co-opers almost in all cases concerned mixed marriage.

Simeon Booker, one of the two Negro members, recalls: "In all our canvassing, there was only one case of extreme negative reaction. However, we did have to correct the impression that we were trying to foster interracial marriage.'

To offset the wave of resentment, FDR House sponsired an open house for neighbors. They were shown through the house and the co-operative plan explained to them. "The open house was a miracle worker," says Booker. "Neighbors entered with stiff, drawn faces, left with
