U.S. Judge May Jail Ala. Sheriff

MOBILE, Ala. (UPI) — An order was signed Friday requiring Sheriff Jim Clark to show cause why he should not be held in contempt for violating federal court orders during Selma right-to-vote demonstrations.

The order was signed by

U.S. District Judge Daniel H. Thomas. The show cause hearing was set for April 26.

The order had been prepared and approved by the judge earlier last week.

Clark was charged with contempt by lawyers representing Selma demonstrator Amelia Boynton in a case in which the judge laid down specific instructions to be followed by voter applicants and law enforcement officers.

Several others, including the circuit and county solicitors, were named defendants and were cited by lawyers for contempt.

Thomas, however, ordered only Clark to defend himself against the contempt charges.

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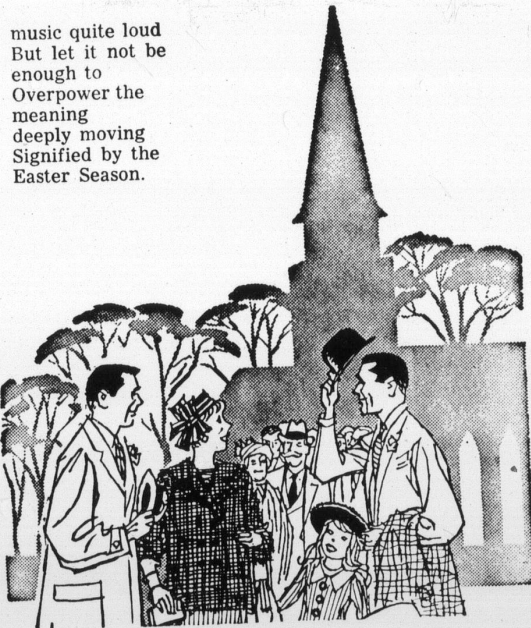
