

MISSIONARY, WIFE DESCRIBE WORK IN NIGERIA TO CATHEDRAL WA GROUP

An illustrated lecture of their work in Nigeria was given by the Rev. Patrick S. H. Phillips, rector of Christ Church, Milverton, and Mrs. Phillips at a meeting of the Evening Branch of the Women's Auxiliary of St. Paul's Cathedral.

Born in India, Mr. Phillips served the Anglican Church in Ghana, was with the Church Missionary Society in Nigeria and spent some time in Burma. Mrs. Phillips served in the Sudan.

Mr. Phillips said that Nigeria is about the same size as Ontario, with a population of 30 million people. He mentioned the difficulties sometimes experienced in bringing the Gospel to some of the natives who are very superstitious and backward and who do not appreciate changing their way of living.

The speaker said the women are kept in the background, doing most of the hard work and raising their families.

Mr. and Mrs. Phillips also displayed a collection of articles and maps from Africa.

Giving is the one way to "Peace on earth. Good-will to men."

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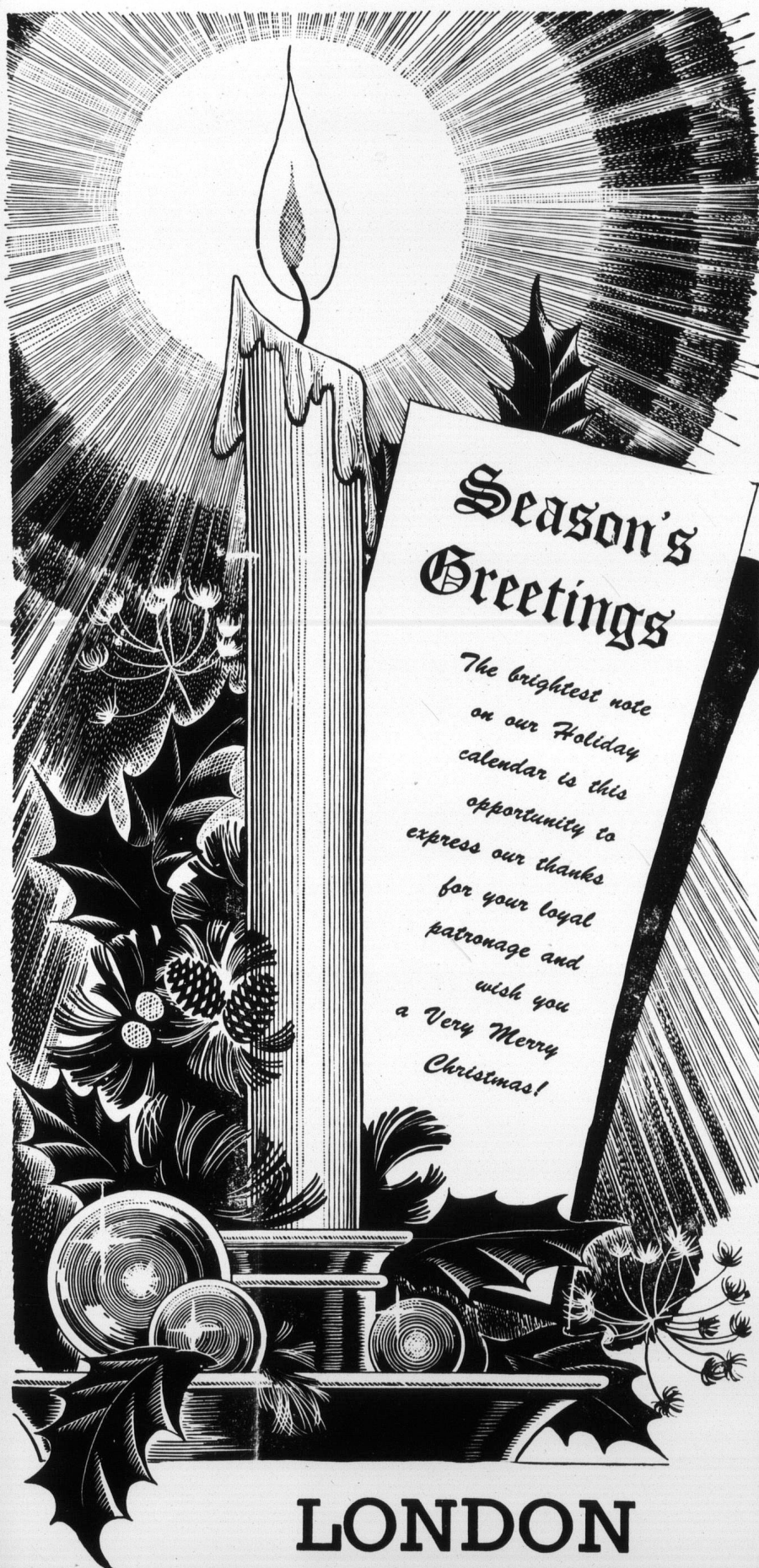
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
