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Red Cross President Denies Racial Bias

NEW YORK, March 13—Gen. Alfred M. Gruenther, president of the American Red Cross, today refuted charges that the Red Cross is guilty of discrimination both in its employment practices and toward Negro blood donors.

"The Red Cross," Gen. Gruenther said, "presently employs, and will continue to employ, qualified Negroes in professional as well as clerical and custodial positions."

The former Supreme Allied Commander in Europe discussed the discrimination charges in an article "The Red Cross Answers its Critics" in the new issue of Look Magazine.

He pointed out that no reference is made to race on the Red Cross employment blanks and that no racial information appears on the personnel IBM data cards.

"We have on occasion sought the referral of Negroes from universities and public and private employment agencies," Gen. Gruenther said. "Negro staff members have been well received throughout the Red Cross."

Bible Today

The question is sometimes followed when a new translation of the Bible is undertaken as to what procedure is in. An answer to the question may be found in the method used when the New English Translation was begun.

The Joint Committee, representing the churches, appointed three panels of translators: one for the Old Testament, one for the New Testament and one for the Apocrypha, each with its own convenor. A panel of literature advisers was appointed also to scrutinize the draft translations and to make criticisms and suggestions on matters of literary style. Each of these panels was made up of specialists in Hebrew for the Old Testament, Greek for the New Testament, and a combination of both for the Apocrypha together with advisers in archaeology and history.

The steps then followed were that the material to be translated was divided between the members of the panel and each member submitted his translation to the whole panel. After being carefully scrutinized it was sent on for examination by the literary advisers. They, in turn, sought to improve the vocabulary, idiom and rhythm of the translation. They had to keep in mind the various levels of language used in the original writers and keep the flavour of the original composition on the appropriate level, for example, in simple narrative, theological argument, rhetoric and poetry. Their work was re-submitted to the translators panel to make sure that the meaning was not changed. When any single book of the Bible was finished it was submitted to the judgment of the Joint Committee. These representatives of the churches then gained the approval of their religious body, to the New Translation.

They have served with great credit with our armed forces overseas and are valued members of our staff."

Answering a question on discrimination toward Negro blood donors, Gen. Gruenther said that the American National Red Cross does not require segregation of blood by race.

The General wrote, "The

objective of the program is to make blood and blood derivatives available to the people of the United States. If necessary to the attainment of that objective in a given locality or area, the blood centers may collect and hold blood in such a manner as to give the physician and the patient the right of selection at the time of administration. The Red Cross does not operate a regional blood center in Louisiana or Arkansas. When it is necessary to ship blood into those states, this is done in conformity with applicable local laws."

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
