Dear Sir,

I am forwarding you herewith copy of Order-in-Council P. C. 977 dated the 3rd May, 1938, which limits the issue of licenses under the Northwest Gene Regulations to the following:-

- 1. Residents of the Northwest Territories as defined by these regulations who at the present time (3rd May, 1936) held hunting and trapping licenses and who continue to reside in the Northwest Territories.
- 2. The children of those who have had their domicile in the Northwest Territories for the past four years, provided such children continue to reside in the Northwest Territories.

You will understand you are ineligible for a licence to hunt and trap in the Northwest Territories since you were not the holder of such a licence on the 3rd May, 1938.
