1. With further reference to the above and to previous reports submitted marginally noted also reports submitted by the Eskimo Pt. Det, 23-3-38. regarding the suspecting illegal trapping in the N.W.T. by the aforementioned party.

2. In this connection, I beg to report that John IVANCHUK has left this part the country during summer 1938 and is now residing at Flin-Flon, Man. where he has started a Bakery, called the "SUNRISE-BAKERY".

3. I have been informed, lately, that the business which Ivanchuk has started at Flin-Flon is not proving successful and he has stated that he intended to return North and trap next winter.

4. I have not the least idea where Ivanchuk, should he return North, will be going, however, it is thought that he will not return to the Casimer River District nor Lac Du Brochet area, owing that the fur catch, this year, has decreased considerably.

5. Further investigation in this connection will therefore be discontinued.

6. Information contained in the 4th. paragraph of this report may become useful for further reference should Ivanchuk return North and applies for license to trap or Trade, as he may apply for a license to trade in the N.W.T.
