I have for acknowledgment your letter of the 11th instant, addressed to the Deputy Minister of Mines, relative to a proposed prospecting trip to the Northwest and Yukon Territories.

In reply I am enclosing for your information copies of the Quartz, Placer and Geme regulations of the Northwest Territories, and copies of the Yukon Quartz and Placer Mining Acts and Yukon Geme Ordinance and Fur Export Tax Ordinance, as well as a selection of literature dealing with these territories.

Mining regulations apply to the Peel River Preserve, but hunting and trapping in this preserve are prohibited.

Regarding the use of a private plane in Canada, you might communicate with the Civil Aviation Branch of the Department of National Defence.
