Memorandum .-

Mr. Turner.

I am sending you herewith a letter received through the Deputy Minister of Mines from Mr. R.O. McMillan, Lawyer, of Bainville, Montana, from which you will observe that it is his intention to make a trip by plane to explore an area in the Northwest Territories which lies between the Mackenzie and the Yukon rivers and which is said to be valuable for mineral. He says that the area in mind is in the Peel River Preserve.

Will you please send Mr. McMillan full information concerning the mining regulations, also respecting the game regulations. It might be well at the same time to ask the Department of National Defence whether any special information should be sent about the use of aeroplanes.
