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To all to whom these Presents shall come—GREETING:

AND WHEREAS

AND WHEREAS Neil Angus Stevenson, of township Twenty-six, range
Twelve West of the Third Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in Our Dominion
of Canada, Farmer,

hereinafter called the grantee has applied for a grant of the said lands and after due investigation has been found entitled to such grant in the terms herein embodied.

Now Know Ye, that by these presents We do grant unto the grantee all that Parcel or Tract of Land, situate, lying and being in the Twenty-sixth Township, in the

Twelfth Range West of the Third Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in Our Dominion of Canada, and being composed of

The South West quarter of Section Twenty, of the said Township

acre **S**, more or less ;

containing by admeasurement One hundred and sixty (160) _____ acre 5, more or less ;

SAVING AND RESERVING, NEVERTHELESS, unto Us, Our Successors and Assigns, the free uses, passage and egress and regress, together with full power to work the same, and for this purpose to enter upon, and use and occupy the said Parcel or Tract of Land; also reserving all mines and minerals which may be found to exist within, upon or under such lands, together with all rights of fishery and fishing and occupation in connection therewith upon, around and adjacent to the said extent as may be necessary for the effectual working of the said minerals, or the mines, pits, seams and veins containing the same; and also reserving thereout and therefrom all rights of fishery and fishing and occupation in connection therewith upon, around and adjacent to the said lands, and also the privilege of landing from and mooring boats and vessels upon any part of the said lands and using the said lands in connection with the rights of fishery and fishing hereby reserved, so far as may be reasonably necessary to the exercise of such rights.

To have and to hold the same unto the grantee in fee simple.

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Provided, and, in pursuance of the *Irrigation Act* it is hereby declared, that these presents shall not vest in the grantee any exclusive or other property or interest in or any exclusive right or privilege with respect to any lake, river, stream or other body of water, or in, or with respect to the water contained or flowing therein, or the land forming the bed or shore thereof.
