Council, and of the Secretary of the Province) and to be thenceforth diferia minated by the Name of the Township of Vingwich and to comprehend the Lands fo prayed for; of which faid Survey you are to make return, noting whether any and what Parts thereof be fit for the Cultivation of Hemp and Flax, together with a Plot thereof, exhibiting thereon the Refervations of one feventh Part thereof for the future Disposition of the Crown, and one other feventh Part thereof for the Support of a Proteftant Clergy, and the Residue divided into Farms or Lots of Two Hundred Acres each, with an Allowance of Five per Cent for Highways, the Breadth or Front of each of the faid Lots or Farms to be one third Part of the Length thereof, or as nearly in that Proportion as Circumstances may permit, numbering the fame Farms on the faid Plot. To the Intent that upon filing this Warrant with the faid Return and Plot annexed under the Signature of you or one of you into the Council Office (which you are to-cause to be done within Six Months from the Date hereof) the Government may be enabled to proceed to grant the fame in the whole or in part as the Royal Instructions may require: And if the return to be made in pursuance of this Warrant shall include any Lands returned under any former Warrant, you shall therein specify the fame, and the quantity thereof for avoiding all double Grants of the fame Land, and the undue anticipation of any Grant, which may be intended to be Patented as of a Date prior to those Lands to be granted under the Return to be made in pursuance of the present Warrant; for which this shall be your fufficient Warrant, and hereof fail not .- Provided always, that Provision be made by the Petitioners for exempting the Crown from more than one Half of fuch Expence as may be incurred for effectuating the running and marking of the Out Lines of the faid Township.
