 that I am Indian Agent for Qu'Appelle Agency, Treaty No. 4

THAT to the best of my knowledge and belief each Indian named on this
 Pay-list is entitled, under Treaty, to the amount set opposite his or her name,
 and that each Indian head of a family has correctly stated the number of the
 members thereof whose annuities are payable to him or her.

AND I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing it to be true,
 and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath, and
 by virtue of "The Canada Evidence Act."
