OME novel features mark the

now well under way. One detail is
the reversal of the fow of the Wel-
land river, whose present mouth,
where it runs into the Niagara, will
become an intake. Niagara water will
fow up the Welland for four miles
and a half, and then through a nine-
mile canal to Queenston at the edge
of the clif that marks the limit of
the present Niagara gorge and the
site of the falls in a former geologic
age. Here will be the power plant,
