An Act to constitute the Rector and Churchwardens of the Parish of Quebec a Corporation for the management of the Finlay Asylum at Quebec.

HEREAS the late Miss Margaret Finlay, of Quebec, who departed Preamble. this life in the year 1849, did, by her last will and testament, bequeath to the Right Reverend George Jehosaphat Mountain, D.D., Lord Bishop of Quebec, the sum of two hundred pounds currency, to be 5 at his absolute disposal for the benefit of the poor belonging to the communion of the Church of England in Quebec, which sum, by subsequent accumulation, has enabled him, the said Bishop, to acquire a property in the City of Quebec, with a wooden house thereon erected, designed, with the aid of further funds which shall for such purpose be available, to form 10 the commencement of an asylum for the aged and infirm, or otherwise disabled persons and distressed widows, being of the communion of the Church of England aforesaid, for ever, under the name and title of the "Finlay Asylum of Quebec:" And whereas it is expedient that provision should be made by law for the due and efficient management of the 15 said asylum, in connection with the parochial authorities of the Church of England in Quebec: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The said Asylum shall be a corporate institution, for the purposes Corporation mentioned in the Preamble of this Act, and the body corporate governing established, and governing the same shall be the Rector and Churchwardens of the parish of Que-body constitu-20 bec, according to the rites of the said Church of England to wit, the ted. Right Reverend George Jehosaphat Mountain, D.D., aforesaid, Rector, William Godfrey Wartele and Edward Poston Esquires, Churchwardens of the said parish, and the successors of the same in their respective offices: And the said body corporate shall, under the said name of the Corporate 25 "Finlay Asylum of Quebec," be able and capable in law to sue and be powers. sued, implead and be impleaded, and shall have the other corporate powers vested in corporations by the Interpretation Act, and shall have power from time to time to make such By-laws and Regulations for the better government of the said Asylum as shall be required or seem 30 beneficial, and to alter or repeal the same and make others in their stead; provided always, that the same be not contrary to the laws of the Pro- Proviso: as to vince of Canada, nor to this Act; and shall also have power to hold, for real property. the benefit of the said Asylum, property, moveable or immoveable: Provided always, that the total value of the real property to be held at any 35 time by the said Corporation shall not exceed five thousand pounds, and shall be such only as shall be required for the actual use and occupation of the Corporation, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned; and that all To be applied the property of the said Corporation, real or personal, shall be applied purposes solely to the purposes aforesaid, and to no other use or purpose whatever. aforesaid.

II. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
