An Act to amend chapter thirty-two of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, respecting the Bureau of Agriculture and Agricultural Societies.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. Sub-sections three and four of section fifty-eight of chapter thirty-two of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, intituled: An Act respecting the Bureau of Agriculture and Agricultural Societies are hereby repealed, and the following shall be substituted therefor and read in the place of the said sub-sections. Con. Stat. Can. Cap. 32 sec. 58 amended.

“3. But the aggregate amount to be granted in any year to such County Societies, shall not exceed in the whole the amount represented by a separate grant of eight hundred dollars to each County Society.” Amount of aid to Agricultural Societies.

“4. The maximum share of the said grant which each Society shall be entitled to receive on the conditions herein specified, shall be fixed from time to time by the Minister of Agriculture, who shall apportion and divide the total amount of the annual grant amongst the said Societies, in proportion to the number of the inhabitants of each electoral division as established by the last decennial census, and the amounts so ascertained shall be the maximum sums which may be granted to the Societies of such electoral divisions respectively, on the conditions aforesaid.” Public aid to be apportioned according to population
