ANNUAL REPORT, 1900.

IN laying before you the Annual Report for the year 1900, it gives me great pleasure to say that the interest shown by the citizens of Toronto in the Library and its Branches has been maintained in the closing year of the century.

As you will see from the tabulated statement which is appended, the total circulation of the Library for home reading for the year was 450,179, and of magazines and books issued in the Reference Library 106,117, or a total for the year of 556,196; whilst in the previous year 442,914 books were issued for home reading, and 103,576 magazines and books were issued in Reference Library or a total of 546,490, a total increase of 9,706, which must indeed be gratifying when we consider that from the statements of many of the foreign libraries we find instead of increase, large decreases in their circulation which tends to show that the citizens fully appreciate the many advantages which the Library affords them, and its great educational influence upon the community.

The Reference Library has been largely increased during the year and I feel glad to say that the Canadian section of it has now become one of the most important in the Dominion and already its value has seriously weighed upon your Board the necessity of taking steps to provide against the many dangers from fire. During a large portion of the day the Reference Library is so fully occupied that the accommodation it becoming very limited and the shelves have become so crowded that more and better accommodation will have to be provided in the very near future as readers are now attracted to it not only from the Dominion but from the United States.

During the year there has been added to the Reference Library a very valuable copy of the Canadian Antiquarian from its first number to date, whose value has been greatly added to by the addition of many valuable and rare plates, original letters, coats of arms and maps, forming a most interesting collection bearing upon the history and early years of this great Dominion.

The lease of the Dundas Street Branch has been renewed for a further period of four years at an annual rental of \$500.

During the year several deputations waited upon the Board, and public feeling became so strong that the Board felt compelled to open a Branch Library at the corner of Brunswick Avenue and College Street and a lease was entered into for two years at a rental of \$40 per month for the first year, and \$45 per month for the second year, and arrangements have been so carried out that the staff has not been increased, the hours during which the Northern and Eastern Branches were open having been reduced. It is gratifying to know that since the opening of the Branch the citizens have shown their great appreciation of it and I am glad to inform you that in point of circulation it has now risen to the second largest Branch in the city.

I am glad to be able to report to you that the general circulation of the Library shows a slight decrease in the amount of fiction, being 62, two per cent. of the total circulation; and whilst in any well conducted library fiction of a desirable kind cannot be excluded, and whilst the amount of fiction may exceed what the Management would desire, the fact nevertheless remains that in comparison with Free Libraries in the United States and foreign countries, the issue of fiction from the Toronto Public Library is much lower than many of the most important libraries in other countries and I am pleased to say is decreasing slowly each year, whilst the circulation of standard works on art, history and science is slowly increasing.

In June last, in company with the Chief Librarian, I attended the meeting of the American Library Association held in Montreal, at which meeting a Provincial Library Association was formed of which our Chief Librarian is the President and has arranged to hold its first meeting in this city in Easter week.

The books purchased during the year included many valuable additions both to the Reference and Circulating Departments.

It was a matter of much regret that the City Council, in 1900, saw fit to reduce the Library estimates of the Board by cutting off the sum of \$2,089 from the amount provided for the purchase of books for the year thereby repeating its action of former years.

On April 14th the Board notified the Board of Control that it was impossible to carry on and maintain the efficiency of the Central Library and its Branches in a proper manner unless the full amount asked for was passed, and on May 12th the Board received notice from the Board of Control of the reduction in its estimates and it appointed a special Committee to wait upon the Board of Control and point out to them the importance of passing the estimates submitted. No attention was paid by the Board of Control and on May 21st the Board requested the opinion of the City's Counsel as to whether the Board was within its rights or was exceeding its Statutory powers, and whether the City Council had the right to refuse the balance of the estimates submitted to them, but the Board received no answer or opinion from the City's Counsel, and failing to get any satisfaction to their communications, in the month of September the Board was forced to institute legal proceedings to define its position and compel the payment by the City of the amount struck out of the estimates.

On December 13th the Honourable Chancellor Boyd delivered judgment upholding the position of the Library Board

and directing the City to furnish the balance of the money asked for and I am glad to say that although the City served Notice of Appeal from his judgment, that it afterwards abandoned the Appeal and paid over the money to the Board.

I greatly regret the action of the Council, but as the position of the Board is now clearly defined I do not anticipate any further trouble, as the Board is well aware that a reduction of the estimates of the year would have entailed a serious curtailment of the amount set apart for the purchase of books, which would have caused considerable inconvenience in a year so prolific of books.

The accounts of the Library have been audited by the proper officers and statements of the receipts and expenditures and of the assets and liabilities are appended.








Eastern Branch, Bolton Avenue.
