Miramichi Advance. CHATHAM, N. B., JULY 3, 1902. THE KING is reported out of danger. Ministerial Bad Faith in Fishery Matters. There is much reason for the feeling that those in charge of Dominion fishery administration care little for the maintenance of the salmon and trout fisheries of New Brunswick, at least, although they must be fully sensible of the fact that the greatest firmness is necessary in refusing to open up new opportunities for bringing about the gradual extinction of these valuable natural assets of the country.

The regular diminution of the numbers of salmon and trout frequenting Canadian rivers flowing through partially settled areas led, years ago, to the adoption of a restrictive policy in regard to net-fishing. The netting of trout was everywhere prohibited about fourteen years ago, and a most inconsiderate measure, the netting of salmon all over Canada in non-tidal waters, was ordered by act of the Dominion Parliament about the same time.

The fact seemed to be borne in upon the Minister of Fisheries at that period that the business of netting salmon and trout was overdone to such an extent as to endanger the existence of those fish. Neither the minister, however, nor anyone to whom he could readily look for advice, appeared to think it necessary to go to the trouble of judiciously applying a restrictive policy. They seem to have found it easier not to inform themselves on the subject. Their location and its environment at Ottawa was far away from the habitat of the salmon and sea-trout and they thought it sufficient to neither know nor care enough about the matter to obtain such information as would enable them to act intelligently in the premises.

Afterwards, the inequality and injustice of their policy became manifest and they were induced to lessen a few of the semi-tidal nets, which had been licensed in defiance of the Fisheries law, and it became the well understood policy of the two ministers of fisheries immediately preceding the present one that no new salmon net stand, in New Brunswick at least, should be licensed.

Meaning, the question as to whether the provincial Government should assume the administration of all the inland fisheries—as they have the right to do under the latest decision of the law officers of the Imperial Privy Council—came up between the local and federal authorities, and the New Brunswick government consented that the Fisheries department at Ottawa, for the present, at least, should continue to administer all the fisheries save those of the inland waters still ungranted by the Crown.

A prominent Miramichi fishery over-seeer enunciates these views on the alleged authority of Professor Prince, and we make the matter thus publicly known in order that the provincial authorities and the people who own these fisheries, may know the attitude of the Ottawa Fisheries department towards them.
