BILL.

An Act to vest in certain inhabitants of the Township of Moore, a Road Allowance therein, and to establish a new road in lieu thereof.

WHEREAS the original allowance for Road in the Preamble.
first or front Concession of the Township of Moore,
in the County of Kent, from Lot number thirty-seven to
Lot number sixty-five, inclusive, has never been opened
5 or travelled upon, by reason of its unfitnes for a road ;
And whereas the owners of the said Lots have dedicated
and set apart another and more convenient road through
the same Lots, in lieu of the said original allowance, and
it is proper to vest the said original allowance in the
10 owners of the said several Lots through which it passes,
and to confirm their said new Road : Be it therefore
enacted, &c.

That the said original allowance for Road, laid out in the Road allow-
ance vested in
the owners of
Lots.
first or front Concession of the said Township of Moore,
15 from Lot number thirty-five to Lot number sixty-five
inclusive, is hereby vested in the several owners of the
Lots through which the same passes, their heirs and
assigns for ever.

II. And be it enacted, That the Road as now laid out Present Road
established
20 and travelled, through the said Lots, is hereby established
and declared to be a public highway through the same,
and shall be of the width of one chain.

III. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be a Public Public Act.
