Act to detach that portion of the Municipality of St. Roch of Quebec, South, lying west of the division line between the property of the Ursuline Nuns and those of the Heirs Tourangeau and Ware, from that Municipality, and to annex the same to the Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, North.

WHEREAS certain inhabitants and proprietors of that portion of **Preamble.**

the Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, South, which lies to the west of the line dividing the property of the Ursuline Nuns from those of the Heirs Tourangeau and Ware, have, by their petition, represented that the easterly portion of the said Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, South, is almost entirely conceded to small building lots, is laid out into streets, and contains already several thousands of inhabitants engaged in the trades and occupations of a town; whereas the westerly portion consists entirely of farms, occupied by agriculturalists, and that the said two portions have no local interests in common, and have prayed that an Act may be passed to detach the westerly portion from the said Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, South, and to annex the same to the Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, North, it being an adjoining rural Municipality with which their interests are identical; and it is expedient to grant their prayer: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

Upon, from, and after, the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, all that part of the present Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, South, which is situate to the west of the division line separating the properties of the Heirs Tourangeau and Ware from that of the Ursuline Nuns in the said Municipality shall be detached from the said Municipality of the Parish of St Roch of Quebec, South, and shall be annexed to, and form part of the Municipality of the parish of St. Roch of Quebec, North.

A certain tract detached from St. Roch of Quebec, South, and annexed to St. Roch of Quebec, North.

This Act shall be deemed a **Public Act.**

1. Under and by virtue of the said will of the said Mahlon Burwell, of the seventeenth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, and the provisions of the said Act entitled: "An Act for the substitution of more simple modes of assurance in lieu of fines and recoveries," the said Leonidas Burwell had and has full power and authority to convey, in fee simple, the lands mentioned and described in the said will, and the preamble of this Act, for and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the said will contained

Public Act.

2. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
