### THIRTY-FIRST ANNUAL MEETING.

---

The thirty-first annual meeting of the Boys' Home, was held at the Home, George St., on Tuesday, February 24th, 1891.

Among those present were : Sir Daniel Wilson, Hon. G. W. Allan, Revs. Dr. McLaren, Dr. Parsons, Dr. Thomas, Street Maclem, Maxwell, W. Patterson, Dr. J. G. Hodgins, Dr. Thorburn, and Messrs. Gartshore, Principal A. Mac-Murphy, Withrow and others.

In the absence of the Mayor, Dr. J. G. Hodgins was called to the chair, and Rev. Dr. McLaren opened the meeting with prayer.

The Chairman then called upon the Rev. Dr. Parsons to read the Secretary's report.

### THIRTY-FIRST ANNUAL REPORT.

---

The Lady Managers of the Boys' Home have much pleasure in submitting to the patrons of the Institution and the public, the 31st annual report, containing full particulars of their labors during the past year, with complete financial statements ; all of which they commend to the careful perusal of those interested in this work.

The year that is past has been no exception to previous terms in the success which has attended the efforts put forth by the Management, for the comfort of so many un-

fortunates, whom they have undertaken to protect, as also for the high state of efficiency within the Home, due so entirely to the untiring exertions of its capable Matron, Miss McKay.

Without the generous support of a sympathizing public, this success could not be attained ; and while returning thanks to their many friends for their kindness in affording means for carrying on this good work, they respectfully solicit that the visits of the collectors may be as marked in the future.

The total number of boys in the Home, Jan. 1st., 1890, was 93 ; admitted during the year, 85. Of this number 16 were sent to situations, 62 were removed by parents or friends, leaving in the Home Dec. 31st, 1890, 101 boys.

Of the 16 sent to situations, 9 have been indentured until they are eighteen years of age, and most satisfactory accounts have been received of their general good conduct. Special pleasure and gratification is felt in mentioning that one of the employers is one of the "old boys," who passed out of the Home many years ago and now desires to extend a helping hand in his turn, to one of this generation. Of the remaining 7 five were returned as unsuited to the wants of the farmer, one ran away, and one, Alfred Spanton, died. The mother of this lad, who was supplied with means to go to her son, expressed herself, on her return, as perfectly satisfied that the little fellow had received every care and attention from the farmer and his wife.

Five boys have, during the year, completed their term of apprenticeship and received either in part or in full, as they desired, the amount placed to their credit during the term of their apprenticeship. Two of these boys have continued farming, one has taken a situation as a tinsmith, and one is learning his trade as a tailor, where their friends trust they may grow into good and useful members of society.

The Management beg to refer to the Medical Officers' report, showing that the general health of the boys has been good, with the exception of the scalp disease referred to in previous reports, but now so nearly eradicated, that strong hopes are entertained of closing the Infirmary at no distant date. In this connection, the Managers express their deep sense of gratitude to Dr. Thorburn, for his unremitting care of the boys, continued through so many years; and to Dr. Caven, who has given special attention to the scalp disease before mentioned.

They would acknowledge, too, their appreciation of the careful and painstaking manner, in which Mrs. Chapman has performed the duties connected with her position as Matron of the Infirmary.

Several changes have taken place on the Board of Managers during the year, and the Managers desire to record their sense of the loss sustained by the Home, through the death of Mrs. John Leys, always a most devoted friend of the institution and its inmates.

Grateful acknowledgement is here made of \$5000.00 received from the executors of the late Mr. William Gooderham, being the first half of the legacy bequeathed by him to the Home. Also \$500.00 from the late Mr. T. M. Thompson.

The Christmas dinner and Christmas tree were most successful, one pleasant feature of which was the resident boys' being waited upon by some of those who had returned from their situations to spend their holidays in their old Home. Thanks are again due to Mr. Osler, for the ten

cent pieces, which he has from year to year distributed at this season among the boys.

The kindness of Mr. Robert Kilgour to his associates in the Sunday school is still continued, also that of Mr. S. B. Brush in connection with the musical department; and Miss Cowan has labored most efficiently in the day school, to all of whom the Board desire to express their gratitude.

An invitation is cordially extended to all who are interested in the welfare and success of the Boys' Home, to visit the Institution, such visits will be much appreciated as an evidence of good will, and an encouragement in the labor.

In conclusion, the Board of Managers would express their devout thankfulness to the Giver of all good, for the many blessings of the past, and desire continued guidance and grace in the future.

#### MEDICAL REPORT.

---

In presenting the 31st Annual Report, it affords the medical officers great pleasure to inform the patrons and managers of the Institution that no deaths have occurred during the past year. Bronchitis and sore throat of a troublesome nature has been more or less prevalent. The scalp disease mentioned in our last report is almost banished from the Infirmary, only four cases now remaining under treatment. It may not be amiss to refer to the small mortality amongst the inmates of the Home since it

was founded in the year 1860 (and not in 1863, as intimated on the stone above the entrance of the building). During these many years over 4,000 boys, whose ages vary from 5 to 14 years, have passed through the institution, the average stay of each boy being about four years; out of that number we have had only 17 deaths, although nearly all the diseases of early life have prevailed from time to time. These results, especially when we consider the constitutions and habits of the boys, and the classes from which they are taken, are remarkable. In the earlier years of the Home the managers had to contend with many difficulties, which fortunately do not exist at the present time to the same extent. Your senior physician will remember these trying times, and now stands almost alone and looks back with thankfulness to a kind Providence for all His mercies.

The good health enjoyed by the boys is in no small measure due to the plain, nutritious food and excellent sanitary conditions of the institution.

During the past year a number of boys whose ages are five years and under have been admitted, and we would suggest that as these lads require special attention, entailing considerable additional expense, the age limit of the Rules and Regulations of the Home be enforced.

In conclusion, your medical officers would again call attention to the advisability of abolishing coal oil lamps, and of lighting the building with gas. This will conduce to the greater safety of the inmates and of the Home. The placing of a telephone in the building would be a great convenience to all connected with the institution.

## OBJECT OF THE BOYS' HOME.

---

### *Duties of the Board of Management and Officers.*

The Institution is open to the boys of the ages mentioned in second Rule of the Regulations, the claims of admission being the utter friendlessness of the applicant, or being a child of drunken or dissolute parents ; the object of this Institution being the prevention of juvenile crime, by training these poor outcasts in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

The management is vested in a Committee of Ladies, chosen from the subscribers, at the Annual General Meeting in February of each year ; the said Committee to consist of thirty-three members, from among whom eight shall be chosen as Directresses ; and among them there shall be a first and second Directress, Treasurer, and Secretary.

The first Directress, or in her absence one other Directress, shall preside at the monthly meetings, audit and sign the accounts presented for that purpose by the Treasurer, propose and declare the resolutions, and sign the minutes of each preceding meeting.

The Treasurer shall receive and keep an account of all moneys belonging to the Institution and also the earnings of all the boys, a separate account of which must be kept with each. All the accounts must be presented each month, at the meeting of the managers, for the signature of the first Directress, or in the absence, the lady presiding.

The Secretary shall conduct all correspondence of the Society ; keep a list of the names, ages, and peculiar circumstances, as far as practicable, of all the boys, in a book provided for that purpose ;

attend at each monthly meeting, take the names of those present, and minute the proceeds in a book, which must be read at each ensuing meeting, and be signed by the presiding lady.

Two members of the Committee in rotation shall visit the "Home" daily, each week ; inspect the house : ascertain from the Matron the conduct of the boys, and enter a report at the weekly meeting on the Monday.

The weekly or Finance Committee shall consist of the Directress, Secretary, Treasurer, and two of the Committee, who shall have been appointed to purchase or otherwise obtain the necessary clothing for the boys. Five shall form a quorum and their order shall be sufficient authority to the Treasurer to advance the money requisite for the above purpose, or supply such things as may be considered necessary for the "Home."

The General Committee shall meet on the second Monday of the month, at 11 o'clock a. m. Each meeting shall be opened with prayer. The minutes of the preceding meeting having been read and signed, the vouchers of the Treasurer produced and signed, the Secretary shall inform the meeting of any correspondence that has taken place during the last month, and the first Directress shall put before the meeting such resolutions as may be put into her hands, take the votes, and declare the decision. Seven shall form a quorum, and when a tie arises, the presiding lady shall give the casting vote. All admissions that have taken place during the past month shall either be ratified or disallowed, at the direction of the meeting.

As soon as the meeting is opened, all conversation not addressed to the presiding lady, shall be pronounced by her to be out of order, and stopped.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BOYS' HOME.

---

I. The Matron shall be competent to take charge of all the boys ; to conduct the household affairs generally ; to admit applicants with the doctor's certificate, subject to the approval of the Weekly Committee ; and she shall daily see to the personal cleanliness of each boy, and every morning and evening conduct family prayer.

II. Boys from the ages of 5 to 14 are admitted as inmates, and none shall be placed in a prominent situation until he has been one year in the Institution. This rule may be suspended under peculiar circumstances, at the discretion of the Managers.

III. The boys shall rise at 6 a.m. from 30th April to 30th September, and at 7 a.m. from 1st October to 1st May ; the time for going to rest being from 6 to 8 p.m. Their meals to be at regular hours—Breakfast at 8 a.m., Dinner at 12, and tea at 5.30 p.m. Grace to be said before and after meals by one of the elder boys ; and all hours not occupied by such meals, or by instruction, to be employed, under the supervision of the Matron, in bodily exercise, house cleaning, or in play.

IV. All the boys shall regularly attend Sunday School, and Divine Service in a Protestant church, every Sunday, in charge of the Matron ; and in the afternoon receive such religious instruction as can be given by the Matron, or any visiting friend to the Institution.

V. The charge for each boy, of parents or friends who are able to pay, shall be \$4 per month, unless an exceptional case shall occur. If more than one boy of the same parents or friends gains admittance, a reduction shall be made, as approved of by the ladies of the Weekly Committee.

VI. Prompt and implicit obedience must be given to the orders of the Matron.
