## The Fishery Laws.

Mr. McDougall's Fishery Bill was taken up by Mr. Campbell and somewhat modified last session as regards the close season. As the Bill will come up again next session for consideration, public attention should be given to the following summary:

It shall not be lawful to fish for or catch white fish in any manner between the fourteenth day of November and the first day of December, nor by any other kind of net or line between the thirtieth day of May and the first day of September in Upper Canada, or between the first day of July and the first day of October in Lower Canada, nor shall the size of the same be at any time destroyed.

PROFITS OF AN ENGLISH BANK.—The London Times says:—The report of the Agents and Masterman's Bank shows the profits for the year ending the 31st of December were £243,120, out of which distributions have been made equal to 20 per cent. per annum leaving £121,312 to be carried to reserve. The reserve fund now stands at £200,000. The paid-up capital is £1,500,000, the deposits are £3,771,155.
