
TORONTO, May 21. Parliament, introduced, it will readily be understood, by a medical gentle-man to make vaccination compulsory. It came up for a second reading on Wednesday night 1:st, but was defer-red for a week. It provides that Municipal Corporations shall appoint for every county, city or town one or more legally qualified and competent medical practitioners for the vaccin-ation of all persons resident within a prescribed locality; that these practi-tioners shall appoint a convenient place for the performance of vaccina-tion once in every month and give due notice of the same; that every child born in Canade shall within a period of six months after birth be backen for vaccination; that proper vertificates shall be given of the fit.
