To the Editor of the Monitor. Sir,—I have recently been asked to sign a pledge binding myself to support, in the coming election, only such a candidate as will openly pledge himself to give his hearty and unreserved support to the immediate enactment of a prohibitory liquor law, irrespective of party.

In the first place the immediate enactment of a prohibitory liquor law by the dominion parliament is out of the question, and any candidate who would pledge himself in favor of such a measure would surely be open to the charge of being ignorant of the present condition of things as regards the power of our legislature.

Secondly, we ought not to ask of a candidate who we are nominating, or who we are supporting, that he should pledge himself to support a measure which he would not support himself.

Thirdly, no less authority than the great Edmund Burke has declared that it is unconstitutional to send pledged men to parliament. It is in the very nature of the position which a representative occupies which requires that he should be free agent, left to pursue such a course on the various questions which come before parliament as his judgment points out as being the wisest in the circumstances.

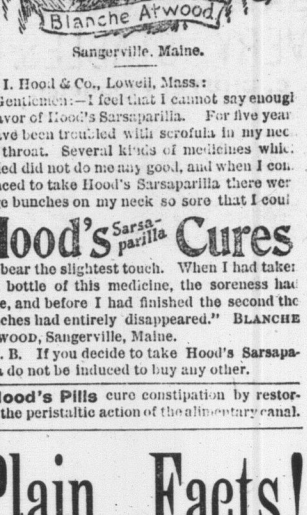
Fourthly, it seems to me that the prohibitionists are doing their cause harm by their course to pledge to support a measure which they do not support themselves.
