CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The most noticeable features of general market conditions are the strength of prices and the marked degree of hopefulness as to the outlook for spring business. There does not seem to be an unfavorable indication. Architects throughout the province have a large volume of work in their hands, with instructions to proceed with huilding operations as soon as possible in the spring. This branch of industry promises to consume fully as much lumber as during the past year, when a very satisfactory trade was done. In the face of the present price of lumber and other materials, the bright cutlook for building is regarded with significance.

There is not the slightest indication of a break in lumber plices. Manufacturers report that the number of buyers visiting their mills is increasing almost daily, and that they show a willingness to contract for stock at current prices. A few manufacturers are accepting \$18 for log-run pine, while others are holding for \$20. There is very little dry stock to be obtained. It is not uncommon to learn of manufacturers who cut as much as 20,-000,000 feet the past neason having less than 1,000,000 feet of unsold stock in their vards.

Everyone in the hardwood trade is looking for an advance in prices. They point out that the appreciation in hardwoods has not been in proportion to that in pine, and that it is each year becoming the mure difficult to secure hardwood logs. For mill-run birch from \$17 to \$18 at the mill is being asked. Dealers are endeavoring to purchase hardwood logs so as to ensure a supply of lumber.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The statement of the wintering stocks at Quebec has been issued and shows a decrease in many items as compared with one year ago. Although the supply of waney pine was 1,830,120 cubic feet, or 400,000 cubic feet more than one year ago, the stock carried over is 100,000

cubic feet less. These figures indicate a materially larger export. Of square pina the stock is 200,000 cubic feet less, resulting largely from a decreased supply. In the hardwoods birch and elm are in lighter stock, while oak and ash are heavier by 60,000 and 25,000 cubic feet respectively. Spruce deals are represented by 8,000,000 feet, a light stock, although 1,300,000 feet more than one year ago. The present outlook is for a strong market in the

In Quenec and New Brunswick logging operations are active, although until reeart'y mild weather prevented successful work in Nova Scotia. The log production will not be excessive. Manufacturers are holding firmly to prices, and from the number of inquiries received expect to have no difficulty in disposing of their season's production at good prices. New Brunswick shingles and laths are still scarce.

MANITOBA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA.

The present quiet season in the lumber trade is welcomed by manufacturers, who will thus be enabled to reduce the number of unfilled orders on their books. The building trade throughout the west was so active last year that in the fall there developed a great scarcity of building material, as the result of which many buildings, especially in the city of Winnipeg, remain in an uncompleted state. Weather conditions until the close of the year were favorable for outdoor work, but it was found impossible to secure material. Every effort will be made to resume work early in the spring, and the movement of tumber in anticipation thereof may be expected shortly. Prices of British Columbia lumber continue firm, with no indication of a decline.

UNITED STATES.

From point of demand from retailers and consumers the past week has been quiet. Prices on all classes of lumber. however, have been maintained. Buyers are new contracting for the 1903 cut, and in many cases the prices paid are higher than one year ago. Fear of a further advance in the spring has stimulated business and brought into the market buyers who intended to defer purchasing until the spring. The outlook for the new cut is very bright, although it is believed that manufacturers will discourage further advances, on the ground that if prices can be kept normal the consumption will be larger. The box shook trade is active and there may be an advance in box material in the near future. At Buffalo and Tonawanda there is a great scarcity of 2-inch cuts, which have been marked up to \$55 to \$57 for No. 1, and \$43 to \$45 for No. 2. A price record was recently made in Boston, when upwards of S100 was paid for wide widths of white pine.

Hardwood lumber is stiffening in price, the scarcity of dry stock being almost without a parallel. Considering the light supply, prices should advance still further. There is no supply of basswood.

The shingle market is a little quiet but stocks are small. In the Saginaw Valley white pine are worth \$3.10 and \$4.15.

GREAT BRITAIN.

Statistics of stocks on hand on December 31st last have been received as yet only from the port of Glasgow. These clearly explain the high price of firstquality pine deals, the stock of which is but 456 standards, as compared with 713 standards one year ago. Of second-quality pine the stock is but 1,186 standards against 507 standards at same time last year. It is difficult to account for the disparity between the two stocks, and many importers are of the opinion that the lower prices for secondquality pine will stimulate consumption. There is a slightly larger stock of third and fourth quality pine, but red pine is less than one-third that of last year. Quobec spruce deals is in heavier stock, the supply being 5,054 standards, against 3,752 standards one year ago. It is not known how far these figures reflect the stock situation at other British centres, but it will probably be found that London and Liverpool have a lighter stock comparatively. The stock of red pine is so light that there should be a favorable opportunity for early imports in the spring. The stock of oak logs is considerably increased from last year, although prices have advanced and now range about 3s. 6d. to 3s. 9d. for legs 48 feet long and 12 inches in diameter. Prices of elm are a shade weaker, w., birch shows a firmer tendency. Ash is dull, partly on account of the unsatisfactory condition of the furnture trade. Prices range from 18s. 6d. for 22-inch average up to 23s. for 15-inch.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

W. W. Carter, of Fesserton, Ont., has five camps in operation at Uhthoff and will have a large stock of logs for next season.

W. H. Higgins, of Vancouver, B. C., who already has two logging camps up the coast, is opening up a third camp at Malaspina Inlet.

The city of Winnipeg, Man., is asking for tenders up to February 3rd for the supply of from 1,000 to 1,500 cords of cedar paving wood.

In the Tonawanda market better prices are being obtained for spruce than for some time, Nos. 1, 2 and 3 being quoted at \$28, \$23 and \$20 respectively.

The Holland & Graves Lumber Company, of Byng Inlet, Ont., are employing between 800 and 1,000 men in the woods this winter and expect to put in 60,000,000 feet of logs.

S. O. Fisher, of Bay City, who is operating near Blind River, Ont., has thirteen camps going and nearly 25,000,000 feet of logs on the skids ready tor hauling. He expects to get in 30,000,000 feet.

The stock of lumber at Cleveland, Ohio, is about the same as at this time last year, although there is a lighter supply of lath and shingles. Stocks are as a rule much greener. Dry lumber is out of the question unless it be kiln-dried.

Timber berths will be offered for sale at the Parliament Buildings, Fredericton, N. B., on January 21st as follows : 16 sq. miles on Cain's river, Thamas W. Flett, applicant; 5 sq. miles on Portage river, Kent county, J. & T. Jardine, applicants ; 41/2 sq. miles on Cain's river, Thos. W. Flett, applicant.

A scarcity of No. 1 elm staves is reported. The second-class staves for apple barrels were not all used up, so an increased amount of this grade is being put into flour barrels. First-class elm flour barrel staves are worth \$8.50 to \$8.75; basswood heading, 5H to 6 cents; hoops, \$11.25 to \$11.50 for 6-foot coiled and \$10.75 to \$11 for 514-foot.

In the Chicago market retail prices on pine piece stuff range from \$17.50 to \$18.50 for short narrow stock up to 2x8, and from \$19 to \$21 for 18-foot and upwards. No. 1 common boards are

quoted at \$20.50 to Beito, No. 2 at \$18.50 to \$19, and No. 3 at \$16. No. 1 shop and better hold exceedingly frm, thick shop being quoted at \$50 f. o. b.

Under date of December 20th Messrs. S. P. Musson, Son & Company say of the Barbadoes market i "Arrivals have been the "Dixon Rice" from Weymouth, N. S., with 219,000 feet spruce and white pine t the "Lillian Blauvelt", from Tusker, N S., with 225,000 feet white pine and spruce ; and the "Lewanika," from St. John. N. B., with 312,000 feet white pine. These cargoes had all been contracted for and will give sufficient for immediate wants, but further supplies will be needed. We could readily place a cargo of sprace at about \$22 to \$22.50 for shipping and \$18 to \$18.50 for seconds. The only arrival of shingles is 168,000 Laying Cedar by the "Lewanika," now on offer. There is very little inquiry at this season, but we hear that a cargo of this description is expected."

Although hardwoods advanced fully 25 per cent. in 1902 the tendency, the Mississippi Valley Lumberman says, is still towards better values, and the market is strong, with active trading. White quartered oak brings \$60 to \$65 in car lots, and red sells at \$50. Basswood is a ready sale at Szo and unward and cottonwood shows a jump of \$10 within a year. There was no let-up in the general inquiry for all kinds of hardwoods the past few days and the point has been raised as to how large consumers are to get along, especially those who have no surplus stock to run for the next five months. Buyers are in the market right along and the trade is above the average for the opening of the year. There are no new features in any wood. All are having a good sale and the trade is gradually becoming accustomed to a higher level of values.

THE OTTAWA VALLEY LOG PRODUCTION.

The estimated output of logs for 1902-1903 is the largest on record. A reliable record shows that on the Spanish, Nipissing and Ottawa rivers, including the Lower Ottawa, probably 9,500,000 logs will be taken out and about 500,000 pieces of cedar, including ties and poles.

The total quantity of square timber and wancy timber for export from Quebec next summer will reach 2,500,000 cubic

Reports from the limits show that the work is progressing satisfactorily, although a scarcity of teams is reported from some districts. Trouble was experienced up to a week ago getting supplies in at certain points on the Upper Ottawa, as the ice was either absent entirely or insecure. Supplies had to be taken across by ferry at a cost five times increased over normal conditions. The intense cold of the past few days has, however, remedied this trouble.

All the deals of the cut of 1903 have been sold, and the ten per cunt. advance over last year's prices mentioned on the first sales made early in the Fall has been maintained. A reference made in a recent letter to a similarity in prices between the two years referred to small lais of lumber picked up for the local or the American markets.

Inquiry at the local railway offices goes to show that lumber shipments are very slow at present. Car shortage and the luli natural to the turn of the year are held responsible for this. There is practically no manufactured lumber on the

TIMBER LIMIT TRANSFERS.

Timber limits in the Maritime Provinces are changing hands quite actively. In Restigouche County, N. B., the Shives Lumber Company have acquired the Muskoka property; the Wm. Richards Company, of Miramichi, now control the Alexander property and Hilyard Bros. and Geo. McKean, of St. John, have just purchased the timber properties of Geo. Mossatt, of Dalhousie. The lim to include 450 square miles in Restigouche county and a large tract in Quebec, and in addition large milling privileges. The price is said to be \$200,000.

C. J. Willis & Company, of Sackville, N. B., have purchased the timber limits and mills in Newfoundland held by the St. George's Lumber Company, which is composed almost entirely of New Glasgow parties. The limits are situated between Bay St. George and the Bay of Islands, and consist of several alternate lots which are intersected by the Reid Railway, and comprise some 300 square miles or about 197,000 acres of virgin timber land. There are splendid saw mills in conjunction. Owing to the lateness of the season only about 8.000,000 feet of logs will be taken out this winter, but it is Mr. Willis' intention to cut from 15,000,000 to 20,000,000 feet each year.


