WILL BRITISH ARMY OFFICERS JOIN ULSTER REBELLION?

Interesting Story From Belfast—Authorities Disquieted by the Increase of Firearms in Ulster—Anti-Home Rule Campaign Opens.

[Canadian Press.] New York, Sept. 18.—A cable to the Tribune from London says: A remarkable story comes from Belfast that before embarking on the present campaign against home rule, the leaders had received the assurance, that in the event of home rule being pressed to its final stage a certain number of army officers, representing every branch of the service, would throw in their lots with the Ulster men.

The list is said to include many officers of high rank, with 25 colonels and lieutenant-colonels, 43 majors, 69 captains, 31 lieutenants, and 288 men holding the rank of sergeant-major or sergeant.
