and bottoms wide well-constructed coops capable of them on legs
or trestles two or three feet off the or tresties two or three feet off the
ground and locating them in the
shade of a tree. The slatted floor compel the hens to stand, which
helps greatly in discouraging helps greatly in discouraging
broodiness. These coops, if con-
