A MURDERER SEIZES THE ISLAND OF MARSHES

Enormous Damage Occasioned and Immense Loss of Life Reported—The London Compartment Outrages—Deeming to Die on Monday Next—Lady Aberdeen on England and America.

LONDON, May 19.—Advice from Mauritius states a hurricane approached in violence passed over that island on April 29, causing enormous damage to shipping, and a majority of the islanders were killed. The western half of the island, the capital, was devastated. Houses were blown down, crops were destroyed and that part of the town was about wiped out of existence.

THE LOSS OF LIFE WAS APPALING

A large number of persons were caught in the falling houses and crushed to death, while others lost their lives by flying debris which they were attempting to seek places of safety.

THE ROLES OF THE GALE WAS DEAFENING

The roof of the gale was deafening, and people rushed to and fro in great confusion with no idea of what they were doing. Rain fell in torrents. The thunder crashed with terrific force, and the flashes of lightning were blinding. Never before in the history of the island has such a war of the elements been known, and indeed there was such widespread fear among the inhabitants.

THE EXACT NUMBER OF DEAD IS NOT KNOWN

Every effort is being made by the authorities to alleviate the suffering that has been caused by the disaster. The Governor has issued orders for military tents to be distributed to shelter the homeless, and food is being sent to the island.
