There are now thousands and tens of thousands of men and women in the west whose hands are tied in idleness. The seductive and alluring circulars that are being scattered throughout the Eastern States are the products of a literary bureau that has been established by employers' Associations, promotion companies and mine owners associations, whose capital expands as hungry and homeless workingmen become fieres competitors on the labor market for jobs.

The voice of discontent is heard all

on account of cheen farce and the mis leading pamphlets that extend such generous invitations to the laboring men of the cast. Stay away from the west! The volcanic rumbling of war between employer and employers are every State of the west, and it is the intention of the corporation's to use eastern immigration as a strike-breaking aggregation. Conflicts between organized labor and organized capital are raging throughout British Columbia, the Pacific slope and inter-mountain region, and the employers of the west who long for larger dividends desire to pit the immigration from the Eastern States against the men of the west who dare to ask for a reasonable remuneration for their toil.

While wages in the west may be a little higher than in the east, the cost of living is far more expensive, and the difference

far more expensive, and the difference in wages is consumed by the higher prices in the necessaries of life. Members of organized labor and all workingmen, stay away from the west until the storm cloud disappears from labor's sky.
