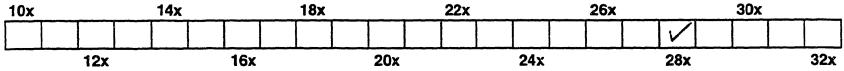

An Act to provide a uniform mode of incorporating Societies formed for Religious, Charitable and Educational purposes.

An Act to provide a uniform mode of incorporating Societies formed for Religious, Charitable and Educational purposes.

HEREAS it is expedient to provide a uniform and eco-Preamble. nomical system of imparting corporate rights to persons associated together for any of the following purposes, that is to say:

Firstly. For the construction or purchase, support and main-Purposes for which Sotenance of any Church or House of Public Worship, or of any cieties may Vestry, Parsonage, Manse, Glebe or other appurtenance of any be incorporatsuch Church or Place of Public Worship;

Secondly. For the purchase and maintenance of suitable 10 grounds and other conveniences for burying the dead;

Thirdly. For the construction or purchase, support and management of any Hospital, Alms House, Asylum or Place of Refuge for blind, deat, dumb, aged, infirm, sick or destitute persons, or for juvenile or other delinquents, or of any House 15 of Industry or of any other Charitable or Benevolent Institution or Association;

Fourthly. For the establishment or purchase, support and management of any Seminary, College, Academy, School, Public Library, Mechanic's Institute or other Literary, Scien-20 tific, Artistic, Agricultural or Industrial Institution:

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the LegislativeCouncil and Assembly of Canada, enacts, as follows:

I. Any five or more persons desiring to be incorporated Declaration in 25 for any one or more of the above mentioned purposes, may triplicate to be make, sign and deliver, in triplicate, to the Registrar of the County Re-County or Union of Counties or of the Registry Division in which gistrar: And the principal Office of the Corporation proposed to be erected, is what it shall to be exactly be a proposed to be erected, is what it shall to be exactly be a proposed to be exactly be contain. to be established, a Declaration in writing, in the form in the 30 Schedule to this Act contained, setting forth, in a clear and intelligible manner, the object or objects for which, and the name under which they desire to be incorporated, and stating the names of the Trustees, Directors or other Managers, and of the President, Secretary and Treasurer, by whom the affairs 35 of the Association are to be managed during the first year of the existence of such Corporation, and the name of the City, Town, Borough, Village, Township, Parish or other place in which the principal Office of such Corporation is to be established.

Certificate of such Registrar, &c., transmission to Provincial Secretary.

II. Upon receiving any such Declaration together with shillings currency, payable a fee of for the same, the Registrar or Deputy Registrar of any such County, Union of Counties or Registry division shall certify upon each triplicate the day of the delivery thereof, and shall 5 deliver back to the persons making such declaration one triplicate thereof, shall transmit another to the Secretary of the Province, and shall file the third of Record in the Registry Office of the County, Union of Counties or Registry Division in which the same is made; And every person shall, at any time there- 10 after, be entitled to have a certified Copy of such Declaration upon paying to the Registrar one shilling for every hundred words therein contained.

Certified copies may be obtained.

III. Upon receipt of a triplicate of any such Declaration by Provincial duly certified as aforesaid, the Secretary of the Province, shall 15 prepare and sign a Notice in the French and English languages, that such Association has been formed, and has made the declaration required by the first section of this Act, and shall cause the same to be inserted in the Canada Gazette published by Authority, once in each of the three weeks which shall 20 follow immediately after the date of such notice.

IV. From and after the day of the date of the first publiof the Society cation of any such Notice, the persons therein mentioned, and their successors, shall be a Corporation or Body Politic and Corporate by the name stated in such Notice, and 25 shall have a Common Seal which they may at their pleasure change or alter, and shall have power to make such By-laws, not inconsistent with the Laws of the Section of the Province in which such Corporation is erected, as they may deem expedient for the election, appoint- 30 ment and removal of the Officers of such Corporation or for the conduct and management of the Affairs and Property thereof, or for any other object connected with the purpose or purposes for which they have been so incorporated, and may from time to time, and at all times, have, hold, acquire and 35 possess in any legal manner whatsoever, for them and their successors, and for the purposes for which they were so incorporated, any Goods or Property, real or personal, and may alienate the same, if need shall be, and may sue, and be sued, implead and be impleaded unto in all Courts and places what-40 soever in all manner of suits, complaints, matters and causes whatsoever.

To what purposes only property shall be applied.

V. No Corporation organized under this Act shall hold or possess any real property not required for the purposes for 45 which it was so organized; and all the property which shall belong to any such Corporation, as well as all the revenues arising therefrom, shall at all times be exclusively applied and appropriated to the purposes described in the Declaration, under or in consequence of which such Corporation shall have 50 been erected, and for no 'er object whatsoever.

VI. A triplicate of a Declaration, such as is required by the Incorporation, first section of this Act, or a copy thereof duly certified by the how provided. Registrar or Deputy Registrar of the County, Union of Counties, or Registry Division, in which the same was received, to-5 gether with a copy of the Canada Gazette published by Authority containing a Notice such as is required by the third section of this Act, shall be received in all Courts and places, as sufficient proof of the erection and existence of the Corporation or Corporate Body therein named, and of the object or objects for which 10 the same was erected.

VII. Every Corporation erected under the authority of this Returns to Act, shall within the first twenty days of every session of Par- Parliament. liament, make a Return to both Houses of the Legislature, and to the Governor of this Province, stating the names of the 15 Members and the gross amount of the receipts and expenditure thereof, during the preceding year.

VIII. Nothing herein contained shall affect, or be construed to Rights of the affect in any manner or way the rights of Her Majesty, Her Crown, &c. Heirs and Successors, or of any person or persons, or of any saved. 20 Body Politic or Corporate created or hereafter to be created, under the Common Law or under the authority of any Royal Grant or Charter, or of any Statute, Law or usage whatsoever, such only excepted as are herinbefore mentioned and provided for.

25 IX. This Act shall be a Public Act. Public Act.
