WOMAN AGAINST WOMAN.

Remarkable as was the testimony in the long-drawn-out case of Marrow v. Youmans, the verdict of the jury, announced at 9 o'clock Saturday night, was a fitting climax.

After a three-day legal battle, in which many family skeletons were resurrected and exposed to the comments of the crowd, the 12 men who were sworn to try the case announced that they could not agree.

The jury deliberated for just one hour, but the foreman said that if they were locked up for six months their opinions could not be harmonized.

Mrs. Macy Bruce was the first witness called when court opened. She said that she was present at the board meeting of the L. P. W. C. at which Mrs. Shepherd admitted that she was wrong about what Mrs. Youmans had said.

Then Mrs. Clara Cleland was called. A pleasant-faced little woman, looking very much troubled, walked toward the witness box. After a few words, Justice MacMahon interposed and endeavored to prevail upon the parties to arrive at a settlement.

'Man could have settled the matter before this, it seems to me,' he said. 'It is strange that women should be so unwilling to do so.'
