Specify by what express.

Records are too fragile to be sent with safety by mail. Great care is exercised in packing and all our receipts from express companies and other carriers are for goods forwarded "in good order." Our liability ceases when goods are delivered to carriers.



HOLDING THE CYLINDER



The wax cylinders should be handled gently at first, until the operator becomes practised.

Thrust the first and second fingers of the right hand into the thick end of the cylinder, and hold it fast by spreading the fingers apart. Touching the outside surface of a prepared cylinder, or record as it is called, destroys its attractiveness and generally its value.




