An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain sums of money required for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government for the year 1858, and for certain other expenses connected with the public service, and also for raising a Loan on the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Most Gracious Sovereign:

TAT HEREAS by Messages from His Excellency Sir Edmund Preamble. Walker Head, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over this Province of Canada, and the Estimates accompanying 5 the same, laid before both Houses of the Provincial Parliament, it appears that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Civil Government of this Province and of the Public Service thereof, for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight: May it therefore 10 please Your Majesty that it be enacted, and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, that,—

1. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this \$2,283,073,1 15 Province, there shall be and may be paid and applied a sum 51cts appronot exceeding in the whole the sum of two million, two hundred priated for and eighty-three thousand, and seventy-three dollars, fifty-one tioned in the cents, for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Schedule. Civil Government and Public Service of this Province for the 20 year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, and other purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

4. Accounts in detail of all moneys received and paid under this Act, and of the Debentures issued and the interest thereon, and of the redemption of the whole or any part of such Debentures, and of all expenses attending the collection and payment of the sums of money collected, received or paid 10 under the authority of this Act, shall be laid before both Houses of the Legislature of this Province at each Session thereof.

And to Her Majesty.

5. The due application of the moneys raised and expended under the authority of this Act, shall be accounted for to Her 15 Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in such manner and form as Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successor shall be pleased to direct.
