The attention of Owners and Masters of British Ships is called to the 74th
"Merchant Shipping Act, 1894,"
74. - (1) A Ship belonging to a British subject shall hoist the proper national colours-
(a) on a signal being made to her by one of sel under the command of an officer of His Majesty's navy on full pay), and
(b) on entering or leaving any foreign port, and
(c) if of fifty tons gross tonnage or upwards, (2) If entering or leaving any British Port. ship in complying with this section, the master ship in complying with this section, the master
of the ship shall for each offence be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds.
At this time of war it is necessary for every
British Ship to hoist the colours and heave to if British Ship to hoist the colours and heave to if
signalled by a British Warship; if a vessel hoists signalled by a British Warship; if a vessel hoists
no colours and runs away it is liable to be fired no colo
upon.
