STAMES OF THE CHINESE . EXPEDITIONARY FOLCES.
F. F. N.

That the wars in South Africa and China tave a perceptible effect upon philately is seen by the numerous questions asked and the interest manifested concerning the provisional issurs of both these countries. To the relief of the great, nations, the disturbances in China have almost been quelled by the Allies. Tts effect upou Oar hobby is well known, for alreddy. several of the great powers are using the stamps of their respective countries to do postal duty in (!hinese territory. The stamps of Japan, Russia, Germany and France had been surcharged for use in this country many months ago. The latest to arrive in the form of surcharged stamps are those of India which have been surcharged for use of the Indian troops now in China with the Allies. In the field post offices attached to the China Expeditionary forces, a difficulty had arisen in the matter of the sale of stamps. For the purposes of calculating, the officials fixed the value of a dollar at 7 s . 11 p ., thus making 1 anna equal to 4 cents plus a considerable fraction, and so it
has been decided to sell stamps in the field at the rate of 4 cents to the anja. As this would have led to the purchase of every stamp in a few hours by the cunning Chinaman to remit to India, the official conceived of a plan and docided to surcharge all the stamps sold by the China Expeditionary Force field post office, with the letters C. E. F. so that they will not be available for use in India. Up to date the folluwing stamps of India have been surcharged with the letters C. E. F.: 1-2 anna, green;1 anna, maroon; 2 annas, blue; 2 1-2 annas, green; 3 anaas orange; 4 annas, olive; 8 annas, red violet; 12 aunas, brown on red; 7 rupee, carmine and green; 3 pies, carmine. Envelopes, 1-2 anna, green Pos‘al cards, 1-4 anna, brown on buff, 1-4x1-4 anna; brown on buff, 1 anna, blue on buff, lxl anna, blue on buff. That this issue of surcharged stamps was a necessicy we are well aware. The Indian Postal Aathorities never had a craze to issue new stamps as have the ever obliging countries of Central and South America. These stamps, in used conditions, are already bringing good prices in India, but it is hoped that the set can be secured at a low figure in future, for the lower the price, the more popular will be the stamps.

## BUYING STAMPS.

33. H. Watt.

Many collectors are careless in baying stamps for their eollection. They are unabl - to resist the temptation to buy because thoy are offered stamps at a big discount. In purchasing stamps every specimen should be as carefully considered as though you were buying as an investment alone. Only perfect specimens should bo bought.

Then, one should consider the actual value of a stamp as opposed to the catalogue value. Many stamps listed at five ente are worth more than others priced at twenty-five celts. Demand makes the catalogue price, while scarcity makes the actual val"e. 1 will $g$ vean instance of tivis. Recently I came into pnesessiod of a lot of Central America stamps, used and on the original cover. Thes were only "Seebecks" and catalogued at a low price, set because they were scarce on the original covers I got ten times catalogue for them. Unused they would have been "gumbuge," but used they were real stamps.

Now, mien you spend a dollar for less) for stamps, consider what yon are doing and invest your money wisely. Don't go after the modern commemorative stamps but search out the dealer who has real stamps for sale and when you spend your money for them you are placing it where it will draw good interest.

I consider the following countries as having the best stamps for investment by the collector who wants stamps that are worth the mones he puts in them: Norway, Denmark, Swecten, Natal, Tasmania, Central America (used only,) Jamaica and Brazil. Others are good, but for myself I prefer the ones named.
