STAMPS OF THE CHINESE . EXPEDITIONARY FORCES.

H. F. N.

That the wars in South Africa and China have a perceptible effect upon philately is seen by the numerous questions asked and the interest manifested concerning the provisional issues of both these countries. To the relief of the great nations, the disturbances in China have almost been quelled by the Allies. Its effect upon our hobby is well known, for already several of the great powers are using the stamps of their respective countries to do postal duty in (!hinese territory. The stamps of Japan, Russia, Germany and France had been surcharged for use in this country many months ago. The latest to arrive in the form of surcharged stamps are those of India which have been surcharged for use of the Indian troops now in China with the Allies. In the field post offices attached to the China Expeditionary forces, a difficulty had arisen in the matter of the sale of stamps. For the fixed the value of a dollar at 7s. 11p., plus a considerable fraction, and so it more popular will be the stamps.

has been decided to sell stamps in the field at the rate of 4 cents to the anna. As this would have led to the purchase of every stamp in a few hours by the cunning Chinaman to remit to India, the official conceived of a plan and decided to surcharge all the stamps sold by the China Expeditionary Force field post office, with the letters C. E. F. so that they will not be available for use in India. Up to date the following stamps of India have been surcharged with the letters C. E. F.: 1-2 anna. green; 1 anna, maroon; 2 annas, blue; 2 1-2 annas, green; 3 annas orange; 4 annas, olive; 8 annas, red violet; 12 aunas, brown on red; 7 rupee, carmine and green; 3 pies, carmine. Envelopes, Postal cards, 1-4 1-2 anna, green anna, brown on buff; 1-4x1-4 anna; brown on buff; 1 anna, blue on buff, 1x1 anna, blue on buff. issue of surcharged stamps was a necessiby we are well aware. The Indian Postal Authorities never had a craze to issue new stamps as have the ever obliging countries of Central and South America. BUYING STAMPS.

By H. Watt.

Many collectors are careless in buying stamps for their collection. They are unable to resist the temptation to buy because they are offered stamps at a big discount. In purchasing stamps every specimen should be as carefully considered as though you were buying as an investment alone. Only perfect

specimens should be bought.

Then, one should consider the actual value of a stamp as opposed to the catalogue value. Many stamps listed at five conte are worth more than others priced at twenty-five cents. Demand makes the catalogue price, while scarcity makes the actual value. I will g ve an instance of this. Recently I came into possession of a lot of Central America stamps, used and on the original cover. They were only "Seebecks" and catalogued at a low price, yet because they were scarce on the original covers I got ten times catalogue for them. Unused they would have been "gumbugs," but used they were real stamps.

Now, when you spend a dollar (or less) for stamps, consider what you are doing and invest your money wisely. Don't go after the modern commemorative stamps but search out the dealer who has real stamps for sale and when you spend your money for them you are placing it where it will draw good

interest.

I consider the following countries as having the best stamps for investment by the collector who wants stamps that are worth the money he puts in them:
Norway, Denmark, Sweden, Natal,
Tasmania, Central America (used only,)
Jamaica and Brazil. Others are good, but for myself I prefer the onea named.

PHILATELY IN WESTERN CANADA.

Western Canada has never been very prominent in a philatelic way. The formation of "The Winnipeg Philatelic Society" has done much to encourage stamp collecting in Winnipeg. only two months ago that it was organized through the efforts of Messra-Blakley and Pitblado, both of whom are prominent business men of this city. Meetings are held the first Thursday in each month and there are now nearly fifty members. Mr. A. L. Griffin is secretary of the society. The Morning Telegram and the Free Press publish stamp columns in their Saturday editions which usually contain articles of merit, and particularly instructive to the younger collector. Then we have a bona fide dealer who is established in pleasant quarters next to the post-office

Mr. A. S. Bertrand, the genial editor of the Jubilee Philatelist of Smith Falls, was a visitor and I regret I missed the pleasure of meeting him.
