BILL.

An Act to amend the Commissioners' Court Act for Lower Canada.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

1. Section Twenty-seven of the Act "respecting Commissioner's Courts for the summary trial of small causes," being chapter ninety-four of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, is hereby repealed, and the following clause is hereby substituted in the place thereof.

"In every warrant of execution, *saisie-arrêt*, *saisie revendication* and *saisie gagerie*, the day on which it is to be returned shall be named ; and it shall be returned with the proceedings thereon duly certified, on the day so named, which shall not be less than ten nor more than forty days from the date of such warrant.
