

Studying Eastern Slope Forests.

The forestry brauch of the Department of the Interior is, this summer, continuing the study of the Torest conditions of the eastern slope of the Rocky Mountains, which was begin a couple of seasons ago by Mr. T. W. Dwight, M. F.

The result of Mr. Dwight's investigations has lately been published in pamphlet form by the Branch as this bulletin No. 33, entitled "Forest Conditions in the Rocky Mountain's Forest Reserve." The forest reserve mentioned, it will be remembered, comprises the entire eastern slope of the Rocky Mountains from the international boundry to a po'nt further north than the latitude of Edmonton. The study takes in only the nouthern patt of the reserve.

In the bulietin referred to, Mr. Dwight describes the trees of the region and discusses the effect on them of militude, aspect and other conditions. He also goes into the effect of area, lumbering, and other factors on the locast and its growth. Methods of lumbering are also discussed, with the idea always in mind of renewing the forest oungetting a eccond trop of timber. Methods followed on the United States 'Rational Forests' in Montans are described in this connections.
