SUPPLEMENTARY PROTOCOL TO THE MOSCOW PROTOCOL OF OCTOBER 8, 1944, TO THE ARMISTICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS AND THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND ON THE ONE HAND, AND FINLAND ON THE OTHER, DATED SEPTEMBER 19, 1944.
