## THE ANNUAL MEETINGS

Of the Society was held on Sunday and Monday, June 10th and 11th, in the Bible Christian Church in Exeter. On Sunday, at 10:30 a.m., a sermon was preached by Rev. W. Medland. A Sabbath school missionary service was held in the afternoon at 2:30, and addresses delivered by Revs. W. Ayers and E. Roberts. At 6:30 p.m., a sermon was preached by Rev. J. Kenner.

On Monday, at 2:30 p.m., a platform meeting was called to order, Mr. W. Field in the chair. Rev R. T. Courtice, Missionary Secretary, presented the Report; after which the following resolution was moved by Rev. G. H. Copeland, and seconded by Rev. W. Jolliffe.

RES. I. That the Report, extracts of which have been read, be adopted and printed, under the direction of the Missionary Committee. We rejoice in the successes achieved by the agents of this and other kindred Societies during the past year; and trust that the blessedness of doing good, whether as collectors or contributors, will increase the zeal and liberality of our people in this most important department of church work.

The evening meeting was presided over by Mr. T. Courtice, and addressed by Revs. W. Limbert, R. B. Rowe and J. Harris. The congregation was large, the interest well sustained, and the following resolution, moved, seconded and supported by the above named brethren, was carried unanimously:

## JUBILATE.

---

Seven weeks of years have rolled their course since John Hicks Eynon and his wife Elisabeth landed at Cobourg, as Missionaries of the Cross of Jesus Christ to the land of the maple leaf.

They were a thank-offering, as unto the Lord, of such as they had, by the Bible Christian Societies in England.

Their work as evangelists was enthusiastically entered upon, and as soon as practicable, reinforcements of like spirit were sought and obtained, to occupy the rapidly enlarging field.

Pioneers of civilization, with characteristic hardihood of mind and muscle, found their way into the interior of the country; transformed forests of trees into grain-fields, and secured homes and prospective wealth.

Misionaries of the several churches followed the early settlers, and while sharing their warm-hearted hospitality, dispensed with mutual joy the bread of life.

The clerical cavalry of those days won glorious triumphs for their king and country.

Their prayers, sermons and counsels did much to cheer and bless the people, and to lay the foundations of national greatness, so broad and so deep that, in civil and religious liberty, sanctity of the Sabbath, love for the Word of God and respect for the Christian Ministry, we stand foremost among the nations.

With grateful hearts we point to our Christian homes, and schools, and churches, and kindred institutions, as the results of labors so faithfully performed by God's servants in times past.

Our Missionaries toiled hard and successfully.

From Belleville to Lake Huron, as well as throughout Prince Edward Island, and in parts lying about Wisconsin and Ohio, they explored the country, and in many districts their names are household words.

To-day, however, we see not the material and territorial results that might reasonably have been expected. These features of disappointment may be accounted for, in part at least, on the following grounds:

Lack of men and means to enter promising fields at a sufficiently early date. Lack of supplies to strengthen or even to retain important though feeble outposts. Heavy expenses incurred by re-opening stations, and the consequent slow and laborious progress.

Nevertheless, our vantage ground in material wealth, divine promises, increasing love for our church polity by the Methodism of this land, the evident tendency of public and prayerful thought towards the unity of our Saviour's prayer, "That they all may be one," fill our hearts with gratitude for the past and hope for the future.

## MISSIONS.

WHEATLY RIVER.—W. E. Reynolds, Pastor.—Congregations continue good, with a slight increase in two places. Many listen attentively to the preached Word. Social means of grace are not so well attended as should be. Our finances are encouraging. The church at Wheatly River has been improved at a cost of \$80, and about \$100 have been raised for school purposes. We want a fresh baptism of the Holy Ghost.

STURGEON.—J. Harris, Superintendent of District.—We have been without a regular minister during the year, hence the interests of this Mission have been neglected. E. A. Tonkin, from Murray Harbor, and J. Pickard, from Charlottetown, supplied the appointments during the first half of the year, and Bro. Tonkin did considerable visiting; but the people were not satisfied, so these supplies were withdrawn. Painful dissensions about the church site continue, and thus what little concert existed among the people has been destroyed. Missionary and quarterly receipts have been expended in providing supplies during the first half of the year. The future of this mission looks dark indeed.

SUMMERSIDE.—J. A. Dafoe, Pastor.—Peace has reigned in our midst, and some tokens of Divine Grace and approval have been received. Prayer and class meetings are regularly sustained, though not largely attended. Sabbath school is well officered and healthy. Special meetings resulted in the quickening of believers and in leading a few to seek the Lord. The heavy debt resting on our Summerside property is very discouraging. We are preaching, praying and working for success.

PORT HOPE.—G. H. Copeland, Pastor.—“Praise God from whom all blessings flow.” Improvements, to the amount of over four hundred dollars, have been made in church and parsonage, Including Sunday School, over thirteen hundred dollars have been raised. Our congregations are good, especially in the evening. Many of our members have their conversation as becometh the gospel of Christ, others do not adorn the doctrines of God, our Saviour. Social means are generally well attended, and are seasons of gracious benediction and spiritual power. Several weeks were spent in Special Services, resulting in the quickening of the Church and adding to our numbers. The Sabbath School is in good working order, and is increasingly prosperous. The Ladies’ Aid Society, organized during the year, has done good service in furnishing the parsonage. May we catch the inspiration of re-consecration to our work, and labor on, until we hear the call, “Up higher, now come.”

CAMPBELLFORD.—J. Kestle and J. H. Oke, Pastors.—The spiritual condition of many on our roll of membership is deplorably low. Evidences:—Irregularity of attendance at the means of grace; little, if any, “brotherly love;” at ease in Zion, with a spirit of worldliness that is most dwarfing and destructive. Of the few, however, better things may be said. In the various departments of church life and labor they bear an honorable part. At 3 appointments special services were held, but with very limited immediate results. We report 4 Sabbath Schools. The one in the village is fairly prosperous; the others exist. The debt on the parsonage is now \$250 instead of \$500, and the balance due on the tabernacle organ has been paid.

BELLEVILLE.—D. Williams, Pastor.—We cannot speak of that degree of visible success attending the church’s efforts that could be desired, yet our labors

have not been in vain in the Lord. A few persons were brought to the Lord at Zion. Special prayer meetings at Belleville have been seasons of blessing, and undoubtedly the Master has recognized good done which has not been visible to us. By aid from other circuits, \$200 have been paid on the church debt. We need more of the mind that was in Christ, and a general baptism of the Holy Spirit.

**PRINCE ALBERT.**—W. Kenner, Pastor. Another.—The past year will long be remembered by many of our friends on this Mission, who have sustained painful bereavements. Some of our standard-bearers, among the most liberal supporters of our cause, have been called to their rest in Heaven. Their places are not easily filled, and we fear we have but few anxious to catch their mantles and sustain the cause of God with the like liberal spirit. The state of the roads and severity of the weather have militated against the special and ordinary means of grace. Two of the Sunday Schools have been closed during the winter, the children not being able to get through the deep snow. Bro. Thompson was, soon after Conference, laid aside by affliction, and after nearly three months returned to his friends. Bro. J. Pearce has rendered valuable service, and by his assistance we have been able to fill most of the appointments. Special services were held at Salem, and a few professed faith in Christ. We want more Christian earnestness, closer fellowship with the Father and with His Son, Jesus Christ.

**PERRYTOWN.**—T. R. Hull, Pastor.—This has been a year of excessive toil. Some of the friends were much discouraged at the beginning of the year, the cause being so very low and the members so few. Special meetings were held at Providence, in November, but stormy weather setting in prevented the regular attendance necessary to success. We continued over four weeks, visiting by day and holding meetings at night. In January an effort was made at Eden. Prospects were fair, but the storms increased, and our meetings closed. Oakhill was given up in February, owing to the Presbyterians re-occupying that ground. Our Quarterly receipts are low. Missionary receipts good, according to membership.

**PETERBORO'.**—W. Jolliffe, Pastor.—The year has not been characterized by an ingathering of souls. Sickness has prevailed in many families and prevented many from a regular attendance on the Word. We have the faithful and constant among us, who are always at the post of duty, then there are the fickle and inconstant who are consequently feeble in religious life. Bro. William Deyell, for many years a prominent member at Bethel, after a long and painful affliction, which he bore with meek Christian resignation, sweetly fell asleep in Jesus and passed away to heavenly rest. Peterboro' School sustains its usual interest.

**FENELON.**—M. Metherell, Pastor.—Congregations are all pretty good when weather and roads are favorable. Good attention is paid to the preached Word. Social means of grace are moderately well attended, and seasons of refreshing are enjoyed in some places. In others, an improvement is the subject of earnest prayer. Meetings were held for five weeks at Ebenezer, nor did we labor in vain. Members were refreshed, and ten persons professed conversion. May God's spirit make His Word effectual.

**LINDSAY.**—W. Limbert, Pastor.—Considerable interest is manifest in the public means of grace. Many give evidence of earnest devotedness to God. We held about four weeks' revival services; the presence of the Lord was graciously realized. A few professed faith in Christ. Since then there has been better attendance at the prayer and class-meetings. We would like to see more

zeal in the service of the Sustained. Our Sabbath school prospects are encouraging.

**MANVERS AND CANTON.**—Circuit is not in as good condition as last year. Many things have hindered the work. We have admitted twenty new members, all of whom are worthy of their Christian profession.

**ASHBURNHAM.**—J. G. Smith, Pastor.—Our circuit is in a favorable condition. The people are acceptable and satisfied with our services. A successful campaign has been made on our debt and interest. Our interest gradually diminished, and has not thus far been paid. We have a school as the nursery of the gospel.

**TORONTO.**—E. R. Smith, Pastor.—A year of marked prosperity has followed upon the previous one. The congregation, and we fear, the whole country, have made it difficult for us to find a suitable place of worship. The social means of grace have been grappled with successfully. The number of communicants has not increased as rapidly as we had hoped. We have an enlarged attendance at our meetings, and are making progress in every way. By Bro. Smith's departure we have suffered great loss. We have lost a valuable member of the Church. We want a new pastor.

**HAMILTON.**—J. W. Smith, Pastor.—A year of marked experience has followed upon the previous one. The Lord's presence has been manifested in various ways. We have made a claim, "O the hope of the world! O the joy of the world! Art thou a stranger in the world? Tarry for the night?" We have had many visitors, and others halted and tarried with us. We have enjoyed sweet enjoyment of spiritual things. Classes have been formed, and we have no appetite for any other employment than that of the Sunday school and the service of God, to be increased.

**PICKERING.**—W. H. Smith, Pastor.—A year of marked experience has followed upon the previous one. The Lord's presence has been manifested in various ways. **MANVERS AND CARTWRIGHT.**—J. Whitlock, T. Brown, Pastors.—This circuit is not in as good a condition, spiritually, as it should be, considering the amount of labor bestowed and prayers offered for the Divine blessing. Several things have hindered the prosperity of the cause of God, but we have not been destitute of God's presence and blessing. In all the means of grace we have experienced times of refreshing, making us joyful in the Rock of our Salvation. We have admitted twenty-four persons on trial for membership, who are walking worthy of their Christian calling.

**ASHBURNHAM.**—J. W. Butcher, Pastor.—A slight improvement is perceptible in both congregation and membership. Bro. Butcher's services have been acceptable and satisfactory. Our friends are few, but help to the best of their ability. A successful church anniversary enabled the Trust Board to meet the interest on our debt and a small balance in hand for other purposes. The S. S. interest gradually diminished while the question of supply was unsettled; the loss has not thus far been regained. This is much to be regretted, as we regard the school as the nursery to the Church.

**TORONTO.**—E. Roberts, Pastor.—The year with us has neither been one of marked prosperity nor advancement. The scattered condition of our congregation, and we fear, in some instances, the want of zeal and love for the cause of God, have made it difficult to secure that regular attendance on the public and social means of grace that is essential to the maintenance of deep-toned piety and faithful labor for the salvation of the unsaved. Our heavy financial liabilities have been grappled with, and a fair measure of success realized. Congregation has not increased as we had hoped. Something must be done to secure, in future, an enlarged attendance. Our Sabbath school holds on in the even tenor of its way. By Bro. J. Binsted's withdrawal, through sickness, the school sustains great loss. We hope a harvest of young immortals will be gathered into the Church. We want a double baptism of the Holy Spirit.

**HAMILTON.**—J. H. Collins, Pastor.—Alternate lights and shadows have marked the experience of the past year. We have not been without evidence of the Lord's presence with us frequently, but we have often been forced to exclaim, "O the hope of Israel, the Saviour thereof in the time of trouble. Why art thou a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man that turneth aside to tarry for the night?" Some have sought and found the pearl of great price; others halted and then closed their ears to the truth. Prayer meetings have afforded sweet enjoyment and profit, but too many manifest a want of relish for spiritual things. Class meetings have fed hungry souls, but spiritual dyspeptics have no appetite for such rich viands. We have peace within our borders, and the Sunday school is in a very hopeful condition. We expect, with the blessing of God, to be increasingly successful.

**PICKERING.**—W. R. Roach, Pastor.—We think the agitation on the Union question has produced stagnation in our work. We have also suffered through the removal of some of our most promising young men. We hear of them from time to time as cleaving to the Lord. We have the most signal evidence of the presence of God with us in class and prayer meetings, in the pulpit and pew, and in our visits to the sick and dying. Some of our schools are prosperous. A Band of Hope has been organized at Ebenezer, which, under God, and with

judicious care, may be rendered a great blessing to the young and inexperienced. May the God of Heaven prosper us yet more and more.

UXBRIDGE.—J. W. Cannom, Pastor.—Many of our public services have been characterized by the operations of the Holy Spirit, and have resulted in several conversions. Prayer and class meetings are well attended, especially by the young people. The Uxbridge congregation has considerably improved, while those in the country remain about the same. Our Sunday school is about as last year. Feeling confident that the Lord of Hosts is with us, and the God of Jacob is our refuge, we hope for greater prosperity in the future.

PALMERSTON.—G. Smith, Pastor.—The continued stormy weather of last winter broke up our special meetings, hence our ingathering was not such as we hoped. Sabbath schools are doing well. In town there has been a great increase in numbers and interest. We have paid off \$200 of our church debt during the year. We believe arrangements might be made with the other churches so that the Lord's work could be carried on more efficiently and economically.

SUTTON.—J. Pooley, Pastor.—Our congregation at Sutton is as good as we have seen it during the two years past. Ravenshoe congregation is also good, considering certain hindrances. Bethel is, as usual, true to the denomination and liberal according to their means. At Egypt our members and congregations have steadily increased. Sabbath schools are fairly attended, but suffer lack of funds and efficient teachers. Finances are very well, considering our numbers.

WIARTON.—S. J. Thompson, (Supply.)—A special service of five weeks' duration was held at Kemble, twenty-five persons professed conversion, nineteen of whom united with our societies. This appointment is the most hopeful in the Mission. We hope to see a church built here. Congregation at Wiarton has increased, and some improvements have been made on our property. We have cause to mourn because of the very apparent want of vital godliness and non-attendance of many at our class and prayer meetings. While on the other hand we rejoice some are showing forth the doctrines of our holy religion by sanctified lives. Sabbath schools are prosperous, and the outlook is brighter than last year.

CLINTON.—J. J. Rice and T. W. Blatchford, B.A., Pastors.—The year has been one of average toil and anxiety, the latter largely owing to the Union agitation, and which, for a time, threatened disastrously. In connection with special services, many precious souls have been gathered in, both at Clinton and Holmesville. At these places congregations have kept up well. In Clinton, seat-holders have increased beyond any previous time. Holmesville and Clinton schools never before were so prosperous. Parsonage, now one of the best, and the property improved almost beyond recognition, adding somewhat to debt, but nothing as compared with the advantage. All appointments outside of Clinton and Holmesville are denominational weak, and, owing to constant removals, steadily declining.

LONDON SOUTH.—A. C. Courtice, B.A., Pastor. Forming our estimate on the fruits that are manifest, we find both discouraging and encouraging features connected with the spiritual state of the church. We have ten or a dozen members who are painfully neglectful of the means of grace ordained unto their spiritual growth, and we have not the least hesitation in saying that their lives are correspondingly barren. We report also that there are now in connection with the church seven persons who have, during the year, turned from the ways

of sin or indifference into love is well worthy of imitation of growth and different character, unmistakable evidence of life. There is room for improvement, numerically and spiritually, on the increase, especially among the older members of the Society.

The remaining forty-five are in different stages of growth and different circumstances of service, all giving, in one way or another, unmistakable evidences of the living, growing genuineness of their spiritual life. There is room for improvement on all sides; but we think that living piety is on the increase, especially among the younger, and measurably among the older members of the Society.

LONDON EAST.—L. W. Wickett, Pastor.—We regret that the life-giving power of godliness has not been realized by us according to the privilege of being strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man, and because so few have experienced the converting power of Divine Grace, when the promises of God are so great and precious. Still there is some cause for gratitude. The flame of Christian love and zeal is not altogether extinguished, and by comparison, numerically or spiritually, we have not suffered. The liabilities have been lessened a little. In the Sabbath school of late there have been signs of prosperity.

LAMBETH.—J. G. Yelland, Pastor.—There is a necessity for a great awakening to the responsibilities of our Christian profession. During several weeks of union revival meetings, held at Delaware, the power of God was blessedly enjoyed. Saints and sinners felt the force of truth, and a few were added to the society. Preaching services have been well sustained. At Delaware the congregations have been exceptionally good. Class meetings are well attended, and are seasons of spiritual refreshing. Financially, we have done well. We have many loyal and deeply interested friends. Peace obtains in our midst. We pray and wait for a fresh baptism of power from on high.

INGERSOLL.—J. Archer, Pastor.—Sunshine and shadow more than usually this year, yet we rejoice that the light has chased away the shade, and our hearts have been filled with gratitude, and our mouths with praise. Quite a number have united with us during the year. Congregations are good. In town, the church is sometimes more than comfortably filled. Societies are in fair working order. Our great need is more of the unity of the spirit. The Sabbath school at Putnam is doing well, but the S. S. in town has suffered through the removal of some of our best workers. Financially, our church has been successful. About \$800 have been gathered. We never labored with a people more willing to work and to keep on working than they are here.

ST. THOMAS.—J. Holmes, Pastor.—Means of Grace have been fairly attended, and have been marked by the divine presence and power. A few, however, have continued to sleep, nor would anything short of a moral earthquake awaken them. A few also have shown a somewhat vagrant disposition, and after a precarious and checkered course, have passed from our fellowship to pastures new, if not more enduring. Union revival services were held with the M. E. and Grace C. M. churches for nine weeks, resulting in much good to the churches and the conversion of many souls. About a dozen have been added to our membership, most of whom are showing a most praiseworthy interest in church work. The Sabbath school continues to do good work, though greatly embarrassed for want of more suitable accommodation. Our financial enterprises have been satisfactory. Some of our friends have tested religion in the midst of trials, and proved it a present help in trouble. We build, though slowly, on a sure foundation.

TALBOTVILLE.—S. H. Rice, Pastor.—The public and private means of grace have frequently been seasons of refreshing, coming from the presence of the

Lord. Union special services were held at Talbotville for some weeks, which were the means of quickening the church and of adding two or three to our numbers. Talbotville Sabbath school has suffered by the removal of several families, while that at Front Street is more hopeful than a year ago. Finances have been well sustained, and harmony has existed between the Pastor and his flock.

WINDSOR.—T. Mason, Pastor.—To all the members of this church God has been abundant in goodness. Attendance at the means of grace has not diminished, nor interest in any way abated. Class and prayer meetings are especially times of refreshing. A Monday afternoon prayer meeting has been held all the year, in the homes of the friends, by the ladies of the church. Some have, through these efforts, been led to Christ, and are now working for His glory. For a deeper work of grace we are willing to pray, believe and work.

COLCHESTER.—W. H. Spargo, Pastor.—We held special services for ten weeks at the various appointments, but the expected results were not realized. Those who might have been saved "would not come unto Him that they might have life." Things are spiritually increasing in interest, especially at Gesto. The morning service and class meeting are enjoyable seasons. The evening services of late show increased attendance and attention. Bro. Hy. Walton has gone to his reward. Some who gave their hearts to God last winter are making progress in the divine life, and bid fair to become useful to the church. We want an outpouring of the Holy Ghost.

NEWBURGH, OHIO.—J. Chapple, Pastor.—Bro. Chapple, with the assistance of the other Preachers on the district, itinerant and local, has regularly supplied the appointments. The want of a resident Pastor is felt, as may be reasonably supposed, nevertheless some success has been realized. Cash raised to the amount of \$462.79, which, with a balance in hand from last year, have met all current expenses, and paid off \$300 of the church debt, besides improvements at a cost of about \$90, incurred in painting and repairs. A resident Pastor is much desired, but in the present state of the denomination respecting union, we deem it expedient to trust to district supplies for the time being.

WISCONSIN DISTRICT.—W. Rollins, District Missionary Secretary, says:—It is with feelings of gratitude to God, the giver of all good and the disposer of the hearts of the children of men, that we review our doings during the past year. Our mission stations, Burlington and Little Prairie, have done very well in sustaining the good cause among them, and our people have nobly responded to the call for funds necessary to supplement what was needed on those two mission fields. Two years ago we were over \$200 in debt in this department; but by strenuous efforts on the part of preachers and people, we have succeeded in liquidating our indebtedness, so that the Conference finds us with a clear balance sheet. It is our purpose from this time forward to pay as we go, and if we can't pay then we shall not go.
