London, Dec. $11(9,35 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{m}$.$) - Of the Five Austro-$ ing sfeady progress in their invasion of Poland, threee have
sufterad checks, according to tonight's official report from Russian headquarters.

ed in one despatch from Petrograde today to be within fif teen miles of Warsaw, after an energetic offensive, was repulsed and under counter attacks from the Russians was compelled to retire at some points.

DRIVEN BACK SEVEN TIMES
The attacks of the main German column, which had its
front on the line between Lodz and Lowica, and which cime down diagonally from Thorn, were delivered with great force but were, according to the Russian account, repulsed with
heavy losses to the invaders. That the Germans laid great store on the success of their attack here is shown by the fact
