An Act to incorporate the Frelighsburg
Grammar School.

An Act to incorporate a Grammar School at Frelighsburg, to be called the Frelighsburg Grammar School.

WHEREAS Jane Freligh of the Village of Frelighsburg in the District of Montreal, widow of the late John Hutchinson, in his lifetime of the City of Montreal, in the said District, Clerk, and widow by a former marriage, of John Baker, in his lifetime of the Township of Dunham, Gentleman, has by petition represented that she is willing to vest in Trustees, to be named under an Act of the Legislature of this Province, certain rights in relation to the estate of her late father, Richard Van Vleit Freligh, in his lifetime of the Village of Frelighsburg, aforesaid, left by him for the purpose of establishing a Grammar School at Frelighsburg, aforesaid, and has also petitioned for the incorporation of the said Grammar School, and it is expedient to accept the said offer and to grant her said petition to the extent hereinafter provided : Therefore Her Majesty &c., enacts as follows :

- I. The said Jane Freligh, and Daniel Westover, of Dunham, and Ambrose Spencer of Saint Armand, and Peleg Spencer, of Saint Armand, Esquires, and the Rector for the time being, of the Parish of Saint Armand East, in communion with the United Church of England and Ireland, and their successors in office, shall be, and are hereby constituted, body politic and corporate, by the name of the "Frelighsburg Grammar School," and shall by that name have perpetual succession and a common seal, with power to alter, renew, or change such seal at pleasure, and power to sue, and be sued, in all Courts of Law or Equity, and shall be vested with all the rights and property of the said Jane Freligh, in and to her late father, Richard Van Vleit Freligh's estate and succession, including all the property and estate, left by him for the establishment of a Grammar School at Frelighsburg aforesaid, under his last will and testament, executed before Dickenson, Notary, and witnesses, at Frelighsburg, aforesaid, bearing date the Twentieth day of November, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine, and the power to call to account the Executor and Trustee named in said will, and all others whom it may concern, for and in respect of the said property, and every part thereof, and besides the above mentioned property and estate, shall have power at all times hereafter to purchase, acquire, hold, possess, and enjoy, such lands and tenements as may be necessary for the actual use and occupation of the said Grammar School, not exceeding in annual value the sum of One Thousand Pounds currency, exclusive of the value of the necessary buildings for the use of the said Grammar School, and of the ground on which they are, or may be erected, and the same to sell, alienate, and dispose of and others in their stead to purchase and acquire, and hold, for the uses and purposes aforesaid.

Certain persons incorporated.

Corporate name.

May hold real property not exceeding in value £1000 per annum.

Trustees appointed—their powers and duties.

II. The said Jane Freligh, Daniel Westover, Ambrose Spencer, Peleg Spencer, and the said Rector for the time being, and their successors in office, shall be Trustees of the said Grammar School, and shall have the control, management, and government thereof, as well in regard to the employment and payment of competent teachers, as the receipt, investment, and management of the revenues and property pertaining thereto, and may from time to time employ any secretaries, clerks, or other useful or necessary servants, and shall also have power to make rules and regulations not contrary to Law, or to the provisions of this Act, for the government and management of the said Corporation, and the affairs and properties thereof, and for all purposes relating to the well-being and interests of the said Corporation, and of the proceedings of the said Trustees in the execution of their duties, including the power from time to time to elect one of their number to be Chairman of said Trustees, and in default of the time or manner of such election being regulated, and until regulated by By-law, a Chairman may from time to time be elected, at any meeting of the said Trustees, or of a majority of them, and such By-law may, by the said Trustees, or a majority of them, be from time to time amended, altered, or repealed, as may be deemed expedient; and all acts and doings of a majority of the said Trustees, shall be of the same force and effect, as if all of them had joined in such acts or doings.

Election of Chairman.

Vacancies among the Trustees to be filled by the Gov. Genl.

III. In case of any vacancy occurring in the number of the said Trustees, by absence from the Province, death, resignation, or otherwise, such vacancies may be filled up from time to time, by His Excellency the Governor General of this Province, who shall appoint fit and proper persons for that purpose.

How the revenues shall be applied.

IV. Out of the property and estate pertaining to the succession of the said late Richard Van Vleit Freligh, which by this Act is vested in the said Trustees, and out of the rents and revenues thereof, there shall first be paid all the expenses incurred in procuring the passing of this Act, and thereafter the said Jane Freligh shall be paid her legacy of seventy-five pounds currency, per annum, and the overplus according to its sufficiency shall be by the said Trustees from time to time invested, in order to get the best revenues they can obtain therefrom, which revenue shall be by them applied for the uses and purposes of the said Grammar School, and the engaging or keeping employed in said Grammar School, at least one preceptor competent to instruct the scholars or pupils in the Greek and Latin languages.

Public Act.

V. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
