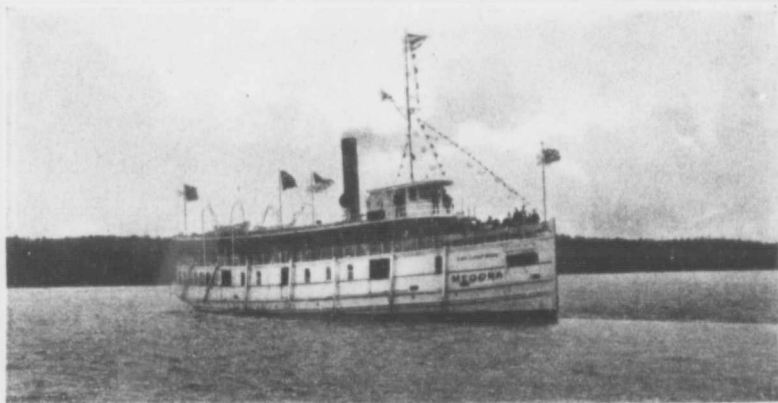

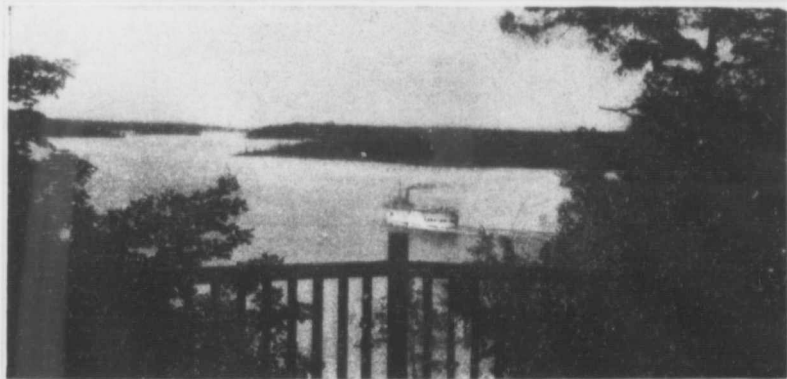
THE MAIN ENTRANCE FROM STEAMER LANDING.

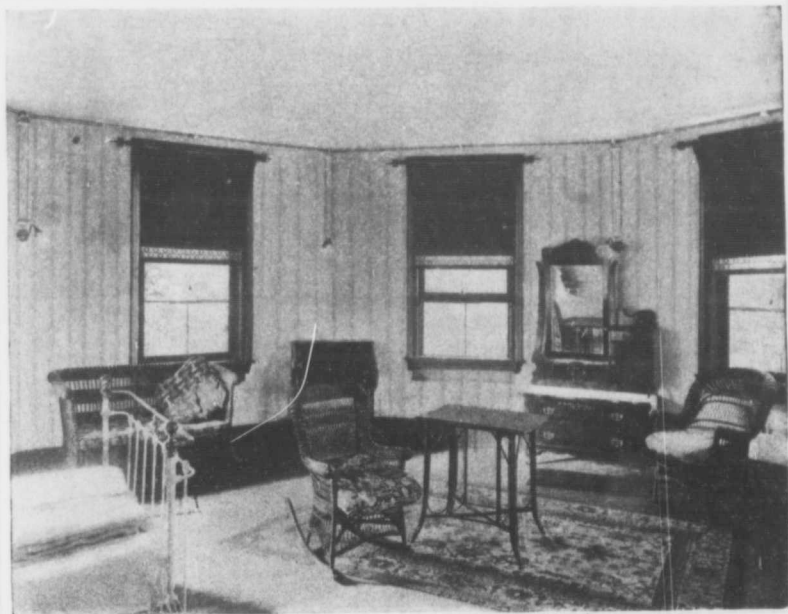

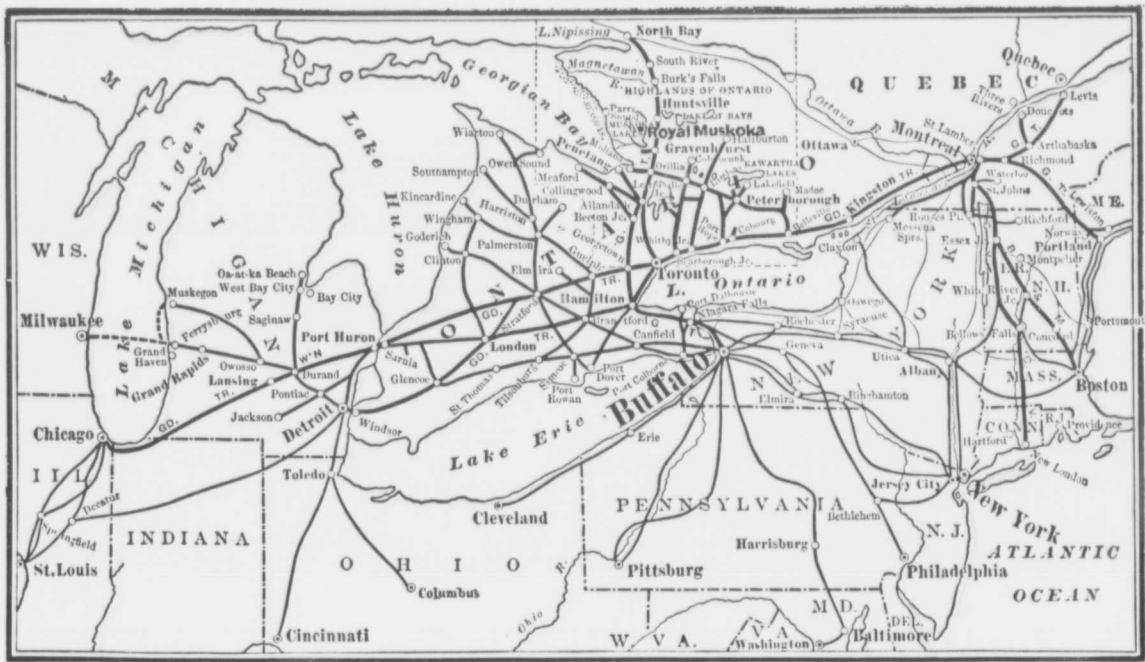
