## FIFTIETH ANNUAL REPORT.

---

*To the Members of the Mechanics' Institute of Montreal:*

GENTLEMEN,

Although we cannot make such a Report as that of last year, yet this, our Jubilee Report, speaks of nothing but progress.

The educational classes have been the largest and most successful ever organized in connection with this Institute, and, notwithstanding the establishment of the Government night schools, we hope to do our part in the education of the mechanics of Montreal.

The income from our property has almost come up to the estimate made a year ago, and, generally speaking, our finances are in a healthy state.

The Library has advanced during the year, though the Library Committee felt the necessity of economy. The number of books in circulation has been larger than ever before.

Some needed alterations have been made in the Central Building, which, together with our building at Point St. Charles, is in excellent order.

The Membership has retrograded somewhat in numbers, but a strong effort is being made to bring it up to a thousand.

All the property of the Institute, both in the centre and at Point St. Charles, is in first-class order. The principal improvement has been the alteration of the stores on St. Peter Street, making the entrance by the street instead of by the passage. The heating apparatus of the Point St. Charles Branch and of Richards' store have been improved, and various minor alterations have been made in all the offices of the central building.

At present the number of unlet offices is nine, and it is hoped that there soon will be a demand for them, situated as they are in the heart of the business part of Montreal.

The revenue from the central building has suffered somewhat from the large number of offices recently erected in the same part of the city. Still the nett revenue from rent, including \$277.25 of unpaid rent, is \$12,369.53, or \$633 below the income as estimated a year ago. If we had been able to dispose of the nine unlet offices, we would have come up to the highest estimate, namely, \$14,500.

The fees from the membership amount to \$1,520.75, against \$1,448.50 of last year, an advance of \$72.25.

An improved system of book-keeping is in contemplation, which will facilitate the work of the Finance Committee.

In November, 1888, classes were opened in the Central Building, the Point St. Charles Branch, and, through the kindness of the Protestant Board of School Commissioners, in Panet Street school-house, and for these schools the very best educational talent was obtained—Mr. Powell of the G. T. R., Mr. L. R. Gregor, B.A., T. A. Mitchell of McGill College and Mr. Isaac Gammall, B.A., all teachers and scholars of the highest culture.

making 160 who availed themselves of the advantages offered. Evidence of the most satisfactory progress of the pupils was given to the Lecture and Class Committee in the frequent visits to the classes and in the work shown at the final examinations.

Classes were held in Panet Street school-house which were attended with a good deal of success, but this year the Government night schools are held in the same place, so that our classes are in abeyance. We are not in possession of a Report from the Local Committee.

For the coming season the General Committee arranged with the Board of Arts and Manufactures to supply a teacher of drawing at the Point St. Charles Branch, and this class already numbers about 40 members.

The important matter of lectures is left to the new lecture and class committee.
