SIXTY-FOURTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT
OF THE
St. GEORGE'S SOCIETY
OF TORONTO,
FOR THE YEAR 1898.

The Committee of Management have pleasure in presenting this their Annual Report.

The relief during the year has been about of the usual character. It is a pleasure to note that the depression which has existed for some years is without doubt fast disappearing, and it is therefore reasonable to hope that during the coming year the resources of the Society will not be so heavily taxed as in the past, to relieve those who have been resident in our midst, but rather will be diverted to render temporary assistance to newly arrived immigrants in our country.

FINANCIAL.

The total receipts from all sources, including the balance of \$37.02 from last year amount to \$2,355.58.

The Treasurer's statement shows that the Society is as on former occasions on a thoroughly sound and substantial footing, being entirely free from liabilities and with a fair workable balance on hand.

The balance on hand at the beginning of the year was \$37.02; cash receipts were \$2,318.56, making a total of \$2,355.54; the expenditure on all accounts was \$2,063.82, leaving a balance of \$291.76.

The Life Membership Fees received during the year (amounting to \$80) are available for investment.

RELIEF.

During the year 825 applicants have been relieved in the usual various ways, and all services rendered by the Society to the applicants. The sum of \$609.06 was expended in conferring this relief. Last year there were 1,275 applicants, being one-third more than this year, a good indication of the return to better times.

Orders for graves in our plot in the St. James' Cemetery have been given for 12 adults and 2 children.

MEMBERSHIP.

There have been nine Life Members elected during the year and thirty Annual Members.

During the year, so far as our knowledge goes, the following deaths have occurred, 3 Life Members and 3 Annual Members, viz. :—

ANNIVERSARIES, ENTERTAINMENTS, ETC.

The Society attended in a body the Annual Anniversary Services held in St. James' Cathedral on Sunday, the 24th of April. An able sermon was preached by the Rev. Provost Welch of Trinity College and the impressive musical service was rendered under the direction of Dr. Ham, Organist of the Cathedral.

The collection amounted to \$101.33.

SMOKING CONCERTS.

The Committee gave very successful Smoking Concerts on the 29th March, and 22nd November. These not only afforded the members a good opportunity for social intercourse, but also produced fair financial results. Profit, \$71.02.

ANNUAL DINNER.

The Annual Dinner was again held in the St. George's Hall on the 25th April, and was well attended. Over

100 gentlemen sat down to the Dinner, which was followed by some excellent speeches and all went off most pleasantly.

PICNIC.

The Annual Picnic was held at Long Branch, but we regret to say was not as successful as it should have been, the attendance being small.

CHRISTMAS DISTRIBUTION.

As usual, the distribution to the English poor was held in the Hall on Saturday, the 24th December, and was of a very generous character, the arrangements for distribution being excellent. The collections amounted to \$1,017.07. The expenditure amounted to \$827.07. The number of families supplied was 648 comprising 3,532 individuals, considerable less than former years.

MR. J. E. PELL.

The Committee desire to add that it is with unfeigned regret that they hear of the contemplated retirement from office of Mr. John Edward Pell, a man who has held the position of Secretary of the Society for the past twenty-four years.

The greater part of Mr. Pell's life has been devoted to going in and out among the poor and afflicted and in

him they have ever found a sympathetic friend and champion.

On the 7th of the month Mr. Pell will finish his eighty-eighth year, a period in his life at which he is surely entitled to the enjoyment of a well earned rest.

Mr. Pell can point with pride to his membership in the Society since the 23rd of April, 1841. It is hoped that a successor will be found who will continue the good work so efficiently carried out by the retiring Secretary.

In conclusion, your Committee desire to thank the large number of members and friends of the Society for the very liberal donations to the objects of the Society.
