STANDING RULES

FOR THE CONSTITUTION AND GOVERNMENT

OF THE

DIOCESAN CHURCH SOCIETY

I. His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor of Nova Scotia, for the time being, and the Societies for the Propagation of the Gospel, and for Promoting Christian Knowledge, shall be respectfully requested to be the Patrons of this Society.

II. The Bishop of the Diocese shall be the President of the Society, with a control over all their proceedings. His approval shall be necessary for the completion of all important acts of the Society, and especially for the revocation or alteration of any of the Standing Rules, and for making any addition to them.

III. There shall be two or more Vice Presidents, of whom the Archdeacon of Nova Scotia shall be the First; a Secretary, an Assistant Secretary, when necessary, and a Treasurer.

IV. There shall be a Standing Committee, consisting of the Officers, all the Clergy, and as many Laymen as it shall be thought convenient to choose at the Annual Meeting of the Society. The Lay Members shall continue in the Committee for a year, or until other Lay Members be chosen in their place; and any or all of them may be re-elected. Seven of the Committee shall be a quorum, provided four of them be Laymen.

V. The Society shall be open to all Members of the Church; all of whom shall be invited to unite with it. Ten pounds, paid at any one time, shall qualify a person to be a Member during his life; and the payment, in advance, of any sum, *however small*, shall qualify a person to be a Member for a year.

VI. The Members of the Church, in every part of the Province, shall be invited to co-operate with the Diocesan Society, by joining Committees of it, which shall be formed under the direction of their respective Clergymen, either in each Mission or Parish, or in more than one Mission or Parish united, as shall be deemed most convenient, and in strict accordance with the design and rules of the Diocesan Society; and it is recommended to the Committees to forward their funds, as they may be collected, to the General Committee, who will faithfully apply them to the general objects of the Society; but when the Local Committees desire it, they shall receive Books, at cost and charges, to the amount of one-fourth of their remittances.

VII. There shall be one General Meeting of the whole Society, including any Members of the Local Committees who can conveniently attend, on such day and at such place as the President may name, of which due notice will be given, with an invitation to every Committee to send at least one Clergyman and two Laymen to represent such Committee, and with a recommendation that each Committee shall meet at some convenient time, immediately before the General Meeting of the Society, that any necessary suggestions may be offered to the representatives of the Committees for their guidance at the General Meeting. And a Special General Meeting may be called at any time and in any place, when the President, or, in his absence, two or more Vice Presidents, shall consider it desirable to appoint such Special General Meeting.

VIII. The objects to which the attention of the Society shall be directed, shall be, generally, those which have engaged the two great Church Societies, in England, for the Propagation of the Gospel, and for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and none other.

IX. The following objects shall more particularly engage the attention of the Society, as soon as their means may enable them to afford such attention:—

- 1.—Supplies of Books and Tracts from the Stores of the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and none other, except in cases where other Books or Tracts, in strict conformity with the principles of the Established Church, and particularly adapted to local circumstances, shall first be carefully examined and approved by a Committee of revision, to be appointed by the General Committee,—the approval of which General Committee shall be necessary in the next place,—after which, the Books must likewise receive the written approbation of the Bishop.

- 2.—Missionary visits to neglected and destitute places, under the direction of the Bishop.
- 3.—Upholding, by all possible and proper means, the Collegiate Establishments at Windsor.
- 4.—Assistance to deserving young men, desirous of being qualified for the Ministry of the Church, but requiring aid in pursuing their studies, at the Collegiate Establishment at Windsor.
- 5.—Aid to Sunday and other Schools, in which due attention is paid to instruction in the principles of the Established Church.
- 6.—Encouragement to the instruction and training of respectable Teachers for Sunday and Daily Schools.
- 7.—Assistance to the erection or enlargement of Churches and Chapels belonging to the Established Religion, in peculiar or extreme cases.
- 8.—Assistance to the erection of Parsonage Houses.

To these objects, generally, the general contributions will be applied; while contributors, who desire it, may have their individual contributions scrupulously confined to any one or more of these objects. And as some Members of the Church, who are not unmindful of the great spiritual wants in their own neighbourhood, still feel constrained, in pious gratitude for the blessings they enjoy, to allot something, however small, from the means with which a gracious Providence has blessed them, towards the spread of the glorious Gospel among the nations which still sit in darkness,—

X. This Society will gladly receive and forward to the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel, whatever sums may be given for the conversion and instruction of the Heathen,—to which object such sums will be strictly confined by the East India Committee of that Society.

XI. Books and Tracts will generally be on sale, at cost and charges;—and whenever, in particular cases, a deviation from this rule is desired, it must be considered by the Standing Committee, and only permitted when recommended by them and approved by the President, or, in his absence, by two or more of the Vice Presidents.

XII. All Meetings of the Society and of the Committees shall be opened and closed with the prayers used by the two Societies in England, adapted to our situation, under the direction of the Bishop.

ELEVENTH REPORT

OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE OF THE

DIOCESAN CHURCH SOCIETY OF NOVA SCOTIA.

The Annual Meeting of the Diocesan Church Society of Nova Scotia, took place in the Masonic Hall, at Halifax, on 28th February, 1849, at 7 o'clock in the evening.

His Excellency Sir JOHN HARVEY took the Chair at 7 o'clock, and as on former occasions, the proceedings commenced by singing the 100th Psalm.

The Ven. the ARCHDEACON offered up PRAYERS. His Excellency Sir JOHN HARVEY, in stating the objects of the Meeting, urged the claims of the Society with great power and effect, and then called upon the Secretary to read the following

THE REPORT.

MEN as we are to witness another Anniversary of the Diocesan Church Society, we would proceed at once to lay before you a statement of the proceedings of the past year, the various undertakings which have engaged the attention of the Committee, and the encouraging success with which their efforts have been crowned. Had the Society achieved nothing more than to call forth the sympathies of Churchmen towards their less favoured Brethren, and unite them more closely in the bonds of love, much had been effected; for the almost uniform testimony of the Clergy is, that in watering others their people have been abundantly watered themselves. One of the Clergy in forwarding the contributions of his people writes thus, "What is done here, is not indeed because we are able to help others, since we are constantly in need of help ourselves, but merely as a pledge of our good will to do so if we could." Another remarks, "It will be gratifying to the General Committee to hear that the objects of the Diocesan Church Society, have not diminished in favour with the people among whom I dwell. I only regret that the pressure of the times is such as to prevent the fulness of their regard from appearing in the amount of our remittance. I may truly say of many of our Members, that out of their very poverty, if not of their penury, have they contributed. In some cases it is literally the widow's mite, and all the living that she had, and in others it is the hardly earned pence of the orphan, that we send you. May a blessing go with it all, and as you spread it broadcast o'er the land, may it be like the bread cast upon the waters, found after many days."

Some additional Subscriptions yet remain to be gathered in for the current year in St. Paul's Parish, Halifax. The Rev. Mr. Millidge writes, that a remittance is about to be sent from Antigonish, and the Rev. Mr. Porter reports a considerable amount as being forthcoming from Cape Breton. These will be acknowledged in next year's Report.

EXPENDITURE.
SCHOOLS. By a Resolution of the General Committee, published in the Appendix of last year's Report, it will be seen that the assistance of the Society is limited to Schools, whereat least the sum of £40 is made up from local sources, and even then the Society will only be able to give £10, or the one-fourth of the sum subscribed, to each School. During the past year three Schools have received aid

from the Society,—one at Margaret's Bay, one at Chester, and one at Weymouth. The sum thus expended amounts to £40.

VISITING MISSIONARIES. IN the Report of last year, your Committee were rejoiced in being able to state, that two travelling Missionaries were then in the employment of the Society, and that the sphere of labour allotted to one of them was the Eastern Shore, and to the other Barrington and the Western Settlements. These Missionaries still continue to occupy the same laborious fields; and if it affords gratification to this Society to know, that many who neglected and despised the ordinances of the Church, have through their instrumentality been brought to prize them—that many who from education or prejudice had been taught to speak evil of our Zion, now speak well of her—and that not a few who had wandered from the good old paths, have been brought back to the fold,—if this be gratifying to the Society, then such ground of gratification is yours abundantly. But we shall best hear from these Missionaries themselves, one of whom is now present, the spiritual destitution which everywhere exists, and the good which God in His mercy has enabled them to effect.

Animated by this first effort of a more directly Missionary character, your Committee have been encouraged to go forward; and by a vote of the Committee at a recent Meeting, it was unanimously Resolved,—“That this Society will employ at least Six Clergymen to minister as Assistants in large Missions, where from the extent of the Mission it is impossible for the resident Pastor to render adequate service—and that the Society will allow £50 to each of these Clergymen, so soon as a similar sum shall have been adequately secured by the people of the Mission.”

The sum expended in this department of the Society’s operations, during the past year, has been £289.

CHURCHES. DURING the past year assistance has been afforded by the Society to the building or enlargement of Twelve Churches, several of which it may be confidently affirmed, would not have been attempted, at least for many years, but for the encouragement given by this Society.

Upon this subject the Rev. Mr. White thus writes:—Two new Churches, exclusive of that of Barrington, have been begun and completed, neither of which in all probability would have been attempted, had it not been for the generous aid extended to us by the great Societies at Home, and their worthy daughter in this Province. One of these Churches already requires to be enlarged to meet the wants of the Congregation; and around the Table of our adorable Redeemer, we now gather forty communicants to commemorate “the sacrifice of the death of Christ, and the benefits we receive thereby.” The other Church has been used for Divine service on every alternate Lord’s Day since the 1st of October, and I doubt not it will prove a

great blessing to the rising village in which it is placed." The communications of the Clergy abound with statements similar to that just read, all tending to shew the great benefits conferred by the Society in the erection of Churches.

The sum expended is £152.

STUDENTS AT WINDSOR. The two Students mentioned in last year's Report, still continue to prosecute their studies with a view to Holy Orders, and to receive aid from the funds of this Society. Several students have been thus assisted since the institution of this Society; but it is to be feared, if speedy and vigorous efforts be not made by the friends of the College, this item of expenditure must soon entirely disappear from our annual Reports. In consequence of the recent action of the Legislature, which has so taken us by surprise, the Provincial Grant, pledged in perpetuity, and enjoyed for sixty years, is threatened to be withdrawn; and unless Churchmen are prepared to act at the emergency demands, this useful Literary Institution must, it is feared, speedily be closed.

The sum expended in this department of the Society's labours, is £60.

BOOKS. The Local Committees have, with few exceptions, received back in Books and Tracts, one-fourth of their remittances; and these silent preachers scattered over the Province by the benevolence of your Society, have been blessed in doing much good. Upon this subject one of the Clergy thus speaks in a recent communication "To say nothing of the Churches in this Parish (three in number) which could not have been erected but for the Society's aid, and in which hundreds are consequently blessed with the Sabbath ordinances, who would otherwise have been without them,—to say nothing of these evidences of good already done, I have frequently seen the happy influence of the Bibles, Testaments, and Prayer Books, and the awakening or comforting Tracts which I have been enabled to distribute by the funds of the Society. Not many days ago I saw a death bed entirely destitute of all earthly comforts, which was yet soothed and cheered by means of one of the Prayer Books which came from your Depository, and was read to the expiring sufferer by a little boy, who had himself been taught to read by other books derived from the same source.

"In many instances also, the Bible or the Testament which our connexion with the D. C. Society has enabled me to bestow on the solitary dweller in our wilderness, or the hardy fisherman on our rocky shores, has been the *first copy* of the life-giving word that has entered his habitation, where it is hoped it may enlighten and convert some darkened soul."

The sum expended in this Branch is £124 17 8.

There have been issued from the Depository during the year, 60 Bibles, 126 Testaments, 956 Prayer Books, 4437 Tracts, 848 bound Books, and other Publications.

In addition to the disbursements already mentioned, there has been paid for printing Reports, &c. £40—for Depository, £25—Masonic Hall, &c. £6,—with other incidental expenses, amounting in all to £925 4 7½ expended during the past year—leaving in the Treasurer's hands up to 1st of January last, £182 4 6, most of which has already been appropriated.

Your Committee cannot conclude this Report without congratulating the friends of the Church upon the cordial and well-sustained support which the Society continues to receive throughout the Diocese. The pressure of the times is widely and deeply felt—in some places the people are destitute of the ordinary necessities of life; yet as a worthy Missionary remarks, "Out of their poverty if not their penury, they contribute to the funds of this Society." But especially would we notice the increased and increasing favour with which the Society is regarded in the Metropolis. The Lealty of Halifax are deeply interested in its fortunes—a general and vigorous effort has, during the past year, been made to increase its funds; and it can now be said in some good measure of the Metropolis, in reference to this benevolent enterprise, as it may be said in reference to its natural position, that it is—a city set upon a hill. For, besides sustaining their own Church Institutions, and bearing their own local burdens, which at the present time are pressing and heavy, the Parishes of St. Paul's and St. George's hope that the day is not far distant, when they shall see Six Missionaries, supported by their own contributions, going forth with the glad tidings of the Gospel to their less favoured brethren, and ministering consolation to the sick and dying in the solitary and waste places of the land.

The Report having been read—

The Honble. The CHIEF JUSTICE moved the First Resolution, viz.:

I.—*Resolved*, That the Report now read be received, printed, and circulated under the direction of the General Committee.

Which being seconded by the Rev. Enwin GILPIN, was agreed to.

Rev. RICHARD UNACKE moved the Second Resolution :

II.—*Resolved*, That this Meeting desires to record its gratitude to Almighty God for His blessing upon the past labours of the Society, and its unshaken trust in His protection and guidance for the time to come.

Which was seconded by Rev. Mr. LEAVY, and passed.

Rev. M. UNACKE Esq. moved the Third Resolution :

III.—*Resolved*, That this Society take the present opportunity to ex-

press their gratification at the successful efforts of the Right Reverend and Honble. the Visitor, the Associate Alumni, and other Friends of King's College, made on behalf of that Institution, the upholding of which Establishment is the third object contemplated by this Society.

W. C. SILVER, Esq., moved the Fourth Resolution :

IV.—Resolved, That the Society have reason again to thank God that the employment of Visiting Missionaries has been so successful an experiment, and that we hail the prospect of obtaining six additional Missionaries for destitute places, with unmixed satisfaction.

Which was seconded by Rev. FITZGERALD UNIACKE, and passed.

JOHN J. MARSHALL, Esq., M. P. P., moved the Fifth Resolution :

V.—Resolved, That the following Members of this Society be elected Members of the Standing Committee for the ensuing year :—Joseph Starr, Henry Ince, Beamish Murdoch, J. G. A. APPENDIX.

AS great inconvenience continues to result from the general practice of the Local Branches, in delaying too long the sending forward of their Reports, attention is requested to the following Resolution, passed at a General Meeting held on 18th February, 1847 :—

Resolved, That in order to ensure the insertion of the proceedings of the Local Committees in the Annual Report of the Society, it will be necessary that their Contributions and Report should be sent forward on or before the 31st day of Decr. in each year.

Inconvenience having been experienced also by the General Committee from the want of attention to the following particulars, the notice of the Presidents and Officers of Local Committees is particularly requested to them, viz. :—

The General Committee meets in Halifax on the third Friday in each month, from November to May inclusive; and all applications for aid should be forwarded to the Secretary, at least a week before either of those dates.

Every application for aid should contain the following information, in defect of which the application must be postponed for fuller particulars :

For aid in the erection of a Church—

- 1.—The precise situation, specially with reference to the nearest Place of Worship, and to the amount of population within five miles of the Church.
- 2.—The Title of the Ground, on which the building is to be erected.
- 3.—The size of the building; the numbers it can accommodate; and probable amount of the congregation that will usually attend it.
- 4.—The supposed cost of the building; the progress it has made towards completion; and the amount of contributions on the spot in money, or labour.

The following Resolutions in reference to Church Schools, were drawn up by a Sub-Committee appointed for that purpose on the 17th of March last; and adopted by the Society:

Resolved. That the General Committee of this Society having reconsidered the regulations under which the Grants to Church Schools shall hereafter be allowed,

It has been determined that the Schools already aided shall receive their usual grants for the current year; and that in future no Schools shall receive assistance from this Society but such as comply with the conditions following:

First.—That the School House be erected on ground, the title of which, with the buildings and appurtenances, is duly secured to the S. P. G., the Bishop of the Diocese, or the Church Corporation of the Parish.

Second.—That the Church Catechism be taught in the School, and other religious instruction given in accordance with the principles of the Church, and under the direction of the Missionary.

Third.—That no application for aid to Day Schools shall be considered at any Meeting of the General Committee, unless the Parish or District shall have subscribed and secured in addition to any public aid, at least the sum of £40, towards defraying the salary of the Schoolmaster.

Fourth.—That any Parish or District complying with the foregoing conditions shall be entitled to receive one fourth of the sum, subscribed and secured as above, from the funds of this Society, so far as its means will allow.

Fifth.—That all grants to Schools shall be deemed and considered to be annual.

Sixth.—That every application shall contain the following information:

- I.—The title to the Ground on which the School House is erected.
- II.—The situation of the School as regards the nearest adjoining School.
- III.—The number of Scholars in usual attendance, and the general circumstances of their Parents.
- IV.—Is the Church Catechism taught, and the School generally conducted with a due regard to the principles of the Established Church?
- V.—The nature of the aid required; whether Books, assistance towards Master's salary, &c.
- VI.—The qualifications and religious profession of the Master, and the branches which he is capable of teaching.
