An Act to incorporate the "International Bank of Canada."

HEREAS William Fitch, Calvin Phelps, Richard Miller, John Preamble. Brown, Archibald Thompson, Richard Martin, Agnew P. Farrell, Witson C. Moore, John C. Kirkpatrick, John Scott, and others, have by their petition prayed, that they and their legal representatives might be h incorporated for the purpose of establishing a Bank in the Town of Cayuga, in the County of Haldimand; And whereas it is expedient to grant the same; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts, as follows;

I. The several persons hereinbefore named, and such other persons as Certan permay become Shareholders in the Company to be by this Act created, sone reorpo-10 and their assigns, shall be and they are hereby created, constituted and declared to be a Corporation, body corporate and politic, by the name of the "International Bank of Canada," and shall continue such Corporate tion, and shall have perpetual succession and a Corporate Seal, with name and genpower to alter and change the same at pleasure, and may sue and be eral powers. 15 sued, implead or be impleaded in all Courts of Law, as other Corporations may do, and shall have the power to acquire and hold real and Real property immoveable estate for the management of their business, not exceeding limited. the yearly value of two thousand pounds currency, and may sell, alienate or exchange the same, and acquire other instead, and may, when duly 20 organized as hereinafter provided, make, ordain and establish such Rules, Regulations, and By-laws as to them shall seem meet and neces- May make sary for the due and proper administration of their affairs, and the due By-laws. management of the said Bank, such By-laws, Rules, and Regulations not being inconsistent with this Act, or contrary to the laws of this Pro-25 vince; Provided, however, that such Rules, Regulations and By-laws Provided shall be submitted for approval to the Stockholders or Shareholders in the said Bank, at their regular Annual Meetings.

II. The Capital Stock of the said Bank hereby incorporated shall be Capital two hundred and fifty thousand pounds, current money of this Province, £250,090 in 30 divided into ten thousand shares of twenty-five pounds currency each, shares of £25 which said shares shall be and are hereby vested in the several persons. which said shares shall be and are hereby vested in the several persons who shall subscribe for the same, their legal representatives and assigns.

III. For the purpose of raising the amount of the said 'Capital Stock, Stock books it shall be lawful for the persons hereby incorporated, or for any number may be openof them not less than five to cause Stock Books to be opened after ed. 35 of them not less than five, to cause Stock Books to be opened, after giving four weeks' public notice in two newspapers in the County of Haldimand, upon which Stock Books shall and may be received, the signatures and subscriptions of such persons or parties as desire to become Shareholders in the said Bank, and such Books shall be opened at Cayuga At Cayuga and elsewhere, at the discretion of the persons opening the same, and and elsewhere.

First meeting for election of directors.

shall be kept open so long as may be necessary; and so soon as fifty thousand pounds of the said Capital Stock shall have been subscribed upon the said Stock Books, and ten thousand pounds paid thereon, a public meeting shall be called of subscribers, after two weeks' notice as hereinbefore provided, at such time and place as such notice shall 5 indicate; and at such meeting the Shareholders shall proceed to elect seven Directors, having the requisite stock qualification, who shall from thenceforward manage the affairs of the said Bank, shall take charge of the Stock Books hereinabove referred to, and shall continue in office until the second Monday in January next thereafter, and until their 10 successors in office shall be duly elected, and the said election shall be had in the same manner as the Annual Elections hereinafter provided for, as respects the regulating of votes according to the number of shares subscribed for.

Shares to be stalments.

IV. The shares of Capital Stock subscribed for shall be paid in and 15 paid in by in by such instalments, and at such times and places as the said Directors shall appoint; and Executors, Administrators and Curators paying instalments upon the shares of deceased Shareholders, shall be and they are hereby respectively indemnified for paying the same; Provided always, that no share or shares shall be held to be lawfully subscribed 20 for, unless a sum equal at least to ten pounds per centum on the amount subscribed for, be actually paid at the time of subscribing; Provided further, that it shall not be lawful for the Subscribers to the Capital Stock aforesaid, to commence the business of Banking, until a sum not less than twenty five thousand pounds shall have been paid in by then: 25 Provided further, that the said Capital Stock shall be subscribed for and paid up as follows, that is to say; the sum of fifty thousand pounds within three years; the further sum of fifty thousand pounds within four years; and the further sum of one hundred and fifty thousand pounds within five years after the said Bank shall have so commenced the busi-30 ness of Banking, under penalty of forfeiture of their charter.

V. If any Shareholder or Shareholders shall refuse or neglect to pay any or either of the instalments upon his, her or their shares of the said Capital Stock, at the time or times required by public notice as aforesaid, such Shareholder or Shareholders shall incur a forfeiture to the use of 35 the said Bank of a sum of money equal to ten pounds per centum on the amount of such shares; and moreover, it shall be lawful for the Directors of the said Bank (without any previous formality, other than thirty days of public notice of their intention) to sell at public auction the said shares, or so many of the said shares as shall, after deducting the reason-40 able expenses of the sale, yield a sum of money sufficient to pay the unpaid instalments due on the remainder of the said shares, and the amount of forseiture incurred upon the whole; and the President or Vice-President, or Cashier of the said Bank, shall execute the transfer to the purchaser of the shares of Stock so sold, and such transfer being 45 accepted shall be as valid and effectual in law as if the same had been executed by the original holder or holders of the shares of Stock thereby Proviso: for transferred; Provided always, that nothing in this section contained, feiture may be shall be held to debar the Directors or Shareholders at a general meeting, from remitting, either in whole or in part, and conditionally or uncon-50 ditionally, any forfeiture incurred by the non-payment of instalment, as aforesaid.

The Directors of the said Bank shall have power to appoint such Cashiers, Officers, Clerks and Servants under them as shall be necessary for conducting the business of the Bank, and to allow reasonable compensation for their services respectively; and shall also be capable of exer-25 Other powers, cising such power and authority for the well-governing and ordering of the affairs of the Bank as shall be prescribed by the By-laws thereof; Pro-Security from vided always, that before permitting any Cashier, Officer, Clerk or Servant of the Bank to enter upon the duties of his office, the Directors should require every such Cashier, Officer, Clerk or Servant, to give bond, to the 30 satisfaction of the Directors, in such sum of money as the Directors consider adequate to the trust to be reposed, with condition for good and faithful behaviour.

It shall be the duty of the Directors to make half yearly dividends of so much of the profits of the Bank as to them shall appear advisable; 35 and such dividends shall be payable at such place or places as the Directors shall appoint, and of which they shall give public notice thirty days previously; Provided always, that no such dividend shall in any manner lessen or impair the Capital Stock of the Bank.

XVI. A general Meeting of the Shareholders of the Bank shall be held in 40 Cayuga aforesaid, on the second Monday in the month of January, in every year during the continuance of this Act, for the purpose of electing Directors in the manner hereinafter provided, and for all other general purposes touching the affairs, and the management of the affairs of the Bank; and at each of the said Annual General Meetings the Direc-45 tors shall submit a full and clear statement of the affairs of the Bank containing, on the one part, the amount of Capital Stock paid in the amount of notes of the Bank in circulation, the net profits in hand, the balances due to other Banks and Institutions, and the cash deposited in the Bank, distinguishing deposits bearing interest from those not 50 bearing interest; and, on the other part, the amount of current coins and gold and silver bullion in the vaults of the Bank, the value of buildings and other real estate belonging to the

Bank, the balances due to the Bank from other Banks or Institutions, and the amount of debts owing to the Bank, including and particularizing the amounts so owing on bills of exchange, discounted notes, mortgages and hypothecs, and other securities; thus exhibiting on the one 5 hand the liabilities of, or debts due by the Bank, and on the other hand, the assets and resources thereof; and the said statement shall also exhibit the rate and amount of the then last dividend declared by the Directors, the amount of profits reserved at the time of declaring such dividend, and the amount of debts of the Bank overdue and not paid, Its form and with an estimate of the loss which may probably be incurred from the contents. 10 with an estimate of the loss which may probably be incurred from the non-payment of such debts.

It shall be made lawful to and for any Justice of the Peace, on complaint made before him, upon the oath of one credible person, that there is just cause to suspect than any one or more person or persons is or are, or hath or have been concerned in making or counterfeiting any false bills of exchange, promissory notes, undertakings or orders of the 95 said Bank, or hath in his possession any plates, presses or other instru-ments, tools or materials for making or counterfeiting the same or any part thereof, by warrant under the hand of such Justice, to cause the dwelling house, room, workshop, or out-house or other building, yard. garden, or other place, belonging to such suspected person or persons, or 30 where any such person or persons shall be suspected of carrying on any such making or counterfeiting, to be searched; and if any such false bills of exchange, promissory notes, undertakings or orders, or any plates, presses, or other tools, instruments or materials, shall be found in the custody or possession of any person or persons whomsoever, not having 35 the same by some lawful authority, it shall and may be lawful to and for any person or persons whomsoever, discovering the same, to seize, and he or they are hereby authorize and required to seize such false or counterfeit bills of exchange, promissory notes, undertakings or orders, and such plates, presses, or other tools, instruments or materials, and to 40 carry the same forthwith before a Justice of the Peace of the County or District (or if more convenient, of the adjoining County or District,) in which the same shall be seized, who shall cause the same to be secured and produced in evidence against any person or persons who shall or may be prosecuted for any of the offences aforesaid, in some Court of 45 Justice proper for the determination thereof, and the same, after being so produced in evidence, shall by order of the Court be defaced or destroyed, or otherwise disposed of, as such Court shall direct.
