

And whereas the very serious inconvenience and hardship under which the inhabitants of the said Territory to be erected into a new County as aforesaid, labour by reason of their remote situation, render it 10 necessary that greater facilities should be afforded for the dissolution of the union thereof with the said other Counties than in ordinary cases: Be it therefore enacted. That no provision relative to the requisite amount of if a proclama- the population of a County to be set apart under the 15 authority of the Act cited in the Preamble to this Act. shall extend to the said County of Grey, and that the said County of Grey shall for all the purposes of the said cited Act be considered and dealt with as if a proclamation had issued under the tenth section of the said 20 Act, naming the Village of Sydenham in the said County as the County Town thereof, and erecting the Townreeves of the said County then elected or thereafter to be elected for the same into a Provisional Municipal Council for the said County, and declaring such Municipal Coun- 25 cil a Provisional Municipal Council for the same under the said Act until the dissolution of the union of the said County of Grey with the said Counties as aforesaid, and that the said Town-reeves shall accordingly be a Provisional Municipal Council for the said County of Grey, 30 and shall have and exercise all the powers by the said cited Act vested in any such Provisional Municipal Council, and that each of the said other Counties shall be held to be a Senior County to the said County of Grey for the purposes of the said Act. 35
